About Little Sprouts

Little Sprouts is an interactive hands-on field trip designed for children 3-5 years old. The program is presented by the Erie County Agricultural Society, as their continuing commitment to agricultural education in Western New York. Field trips are offered in the Little Hands on the Farm Exhibit and the state-of- the-art Agriculture Discovery Center. The field trips are specifically designed to teach children about the importance of agriculture in their lives through a hands on approach. All lessons are age appropriate and interactive.

The field trip will run through the interactive "farm". There are ten barns that all represent a piece of a working farm. This field trip will allow the children to experience what it would be like to work on a farm and practice the everyday chores. They will have the opportunity to milk a pretend cow, collect some wooden eggs from the chicken coop, ride a pedal tractor and much more! After finishing all of the work they will sell their products at the "farmer's market" and even have the chance to go grocery shopping.

Children will be split into two groups and spend half of the field trip at Little Hands on the Farm and the other half inside Reservations the Agriculture Discovery Center learning about an age appropriate agriculture topic and making a craft to take home.
