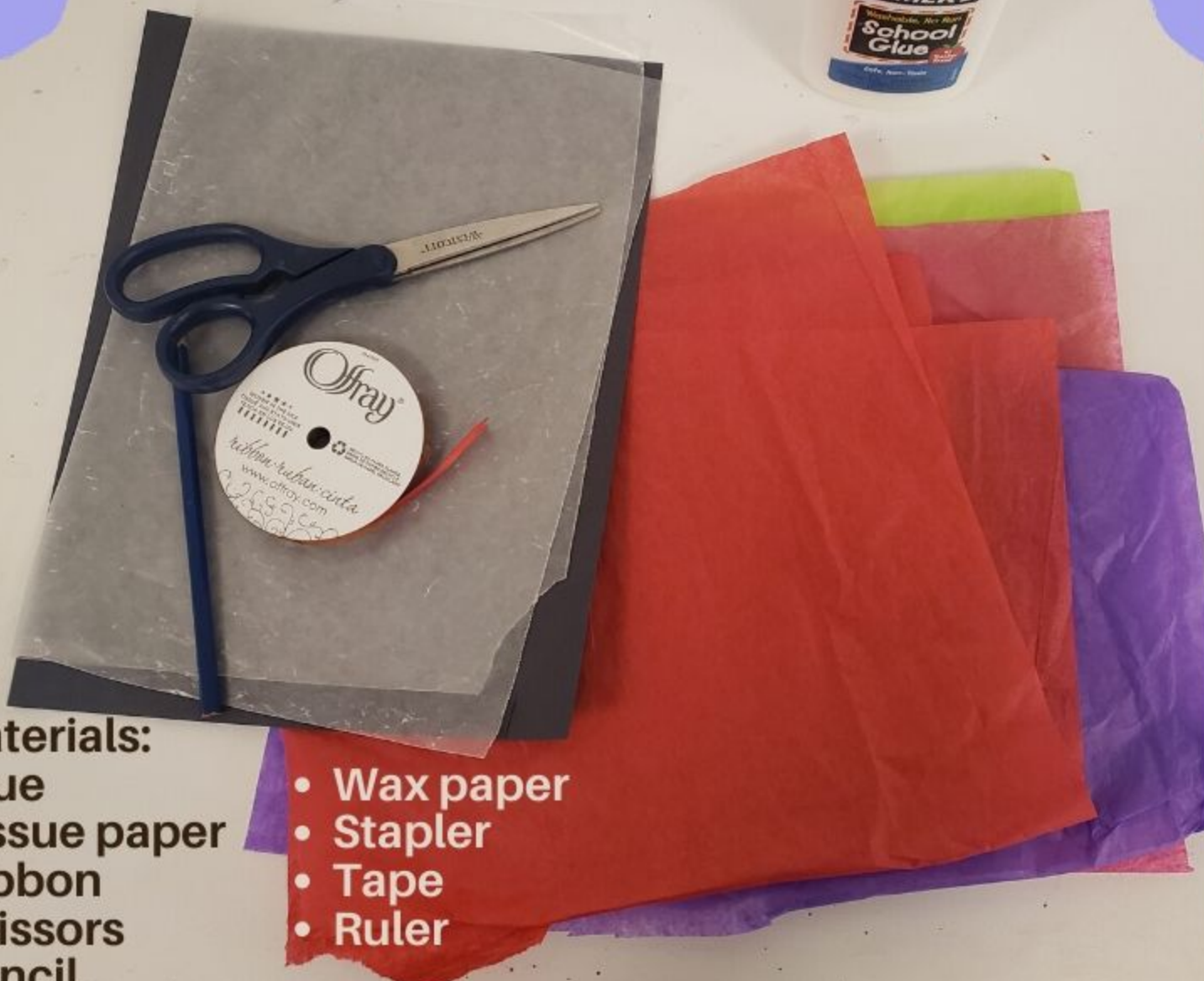

Kite Sun Catcher Part I

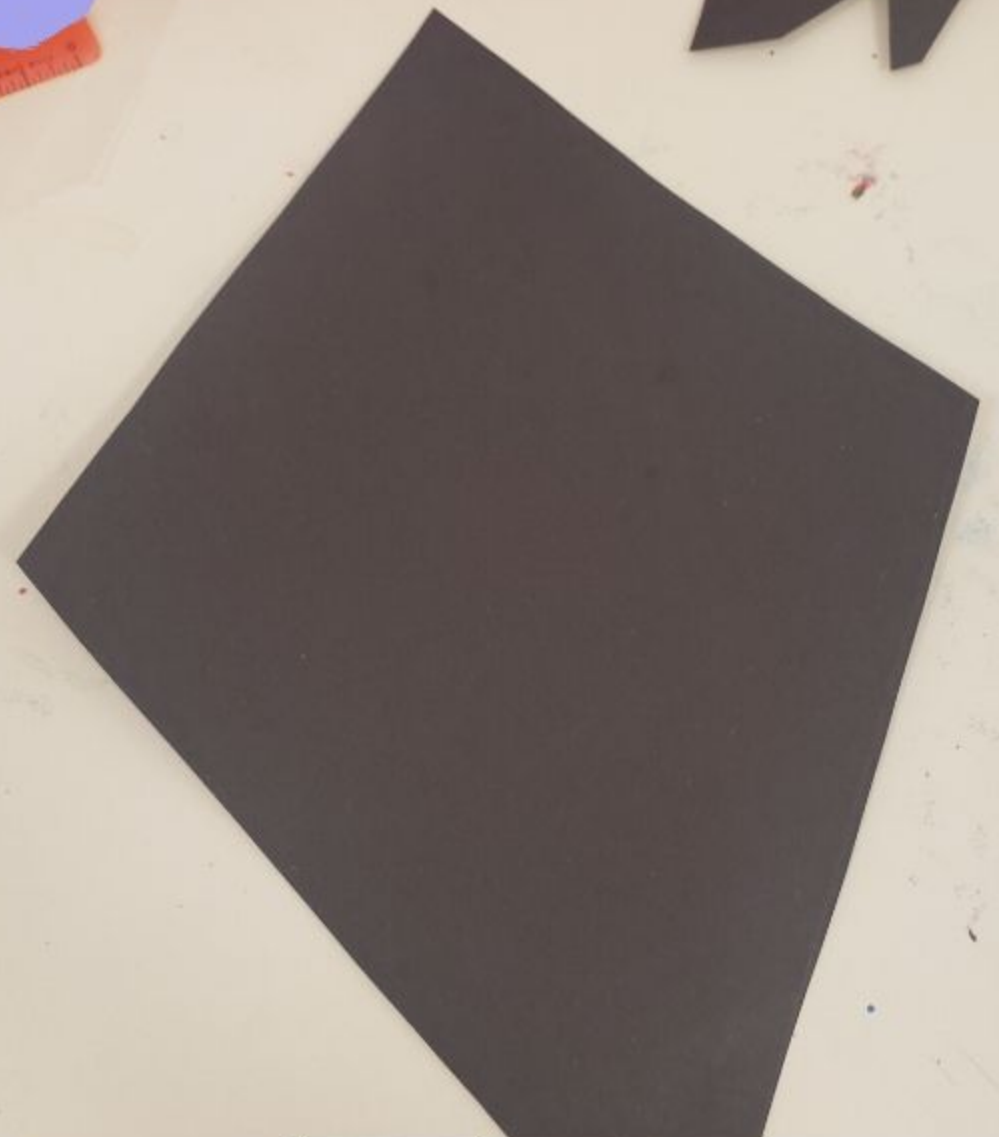


Materials:

- Glue
- Tissue paper
- Ribbon
- Scissors
- Pencil
- Wax paper
- Stapler
- Tape
- Ruler

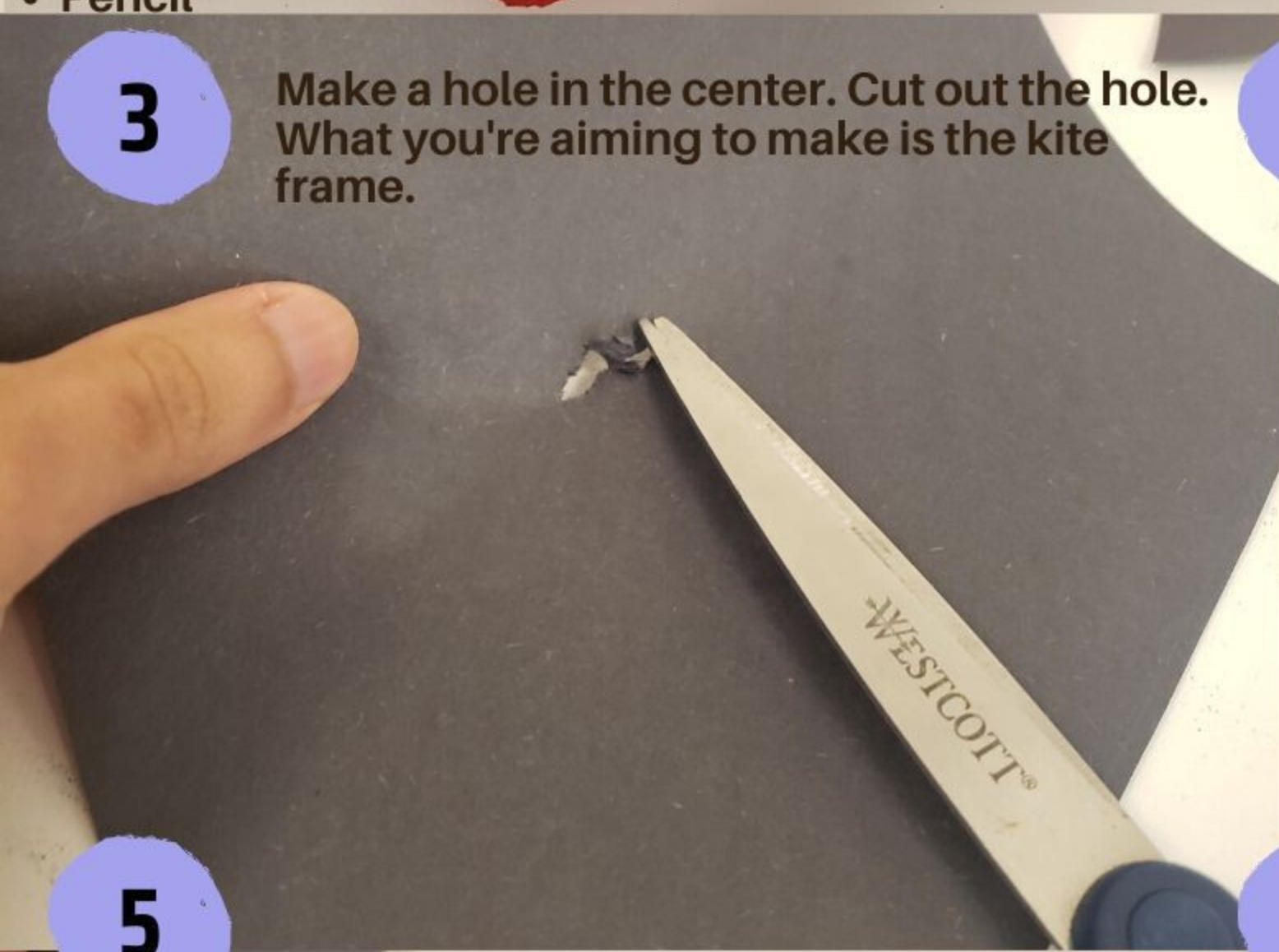

Draw & cut out a large diamond shape.



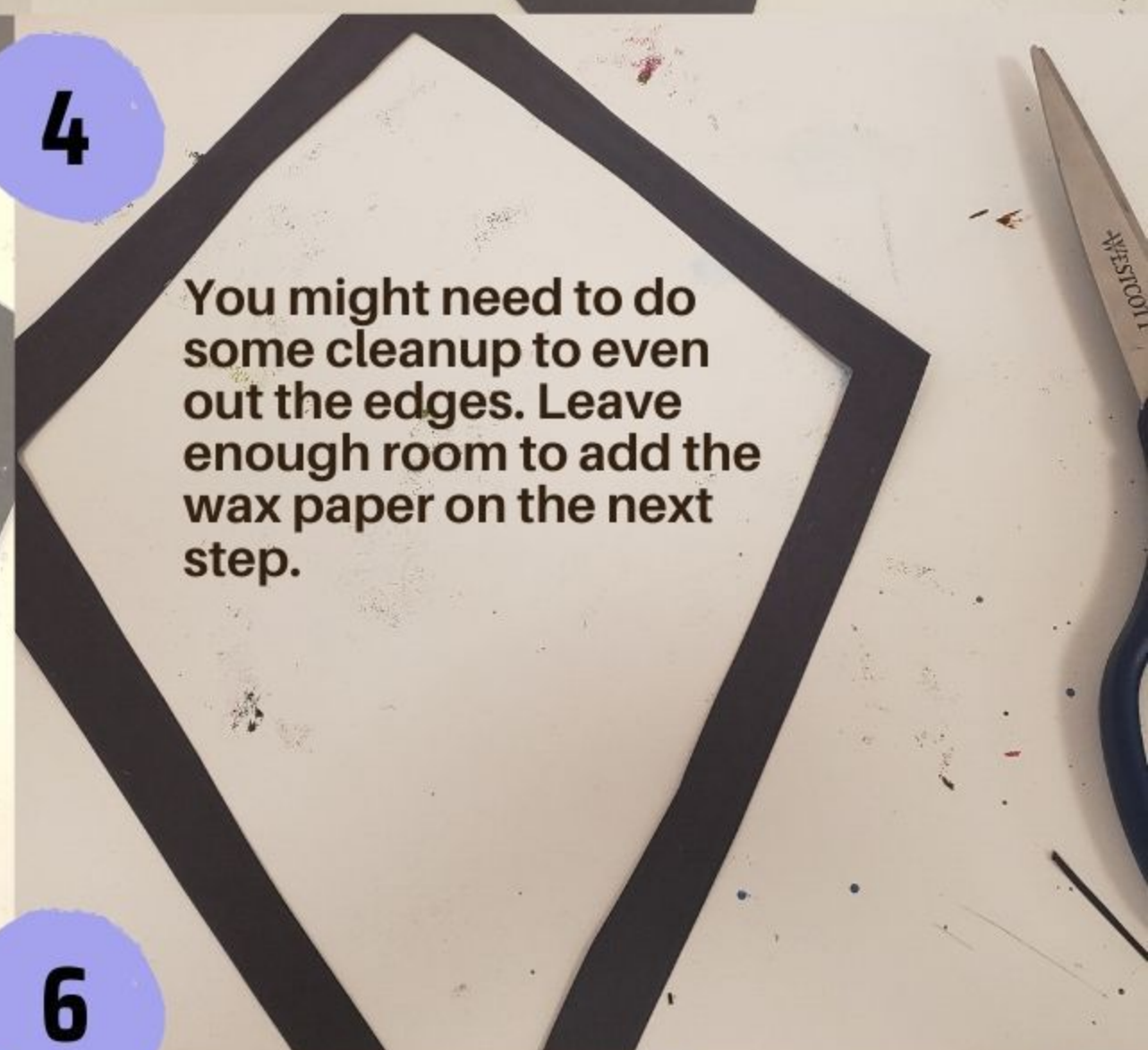

Make a hole in the center. Cut out the hole. What you're aiming to make is the kite frame.

You might need to do some cleanup to even out the edges. Leave enough room to add the wax paper on the next step.



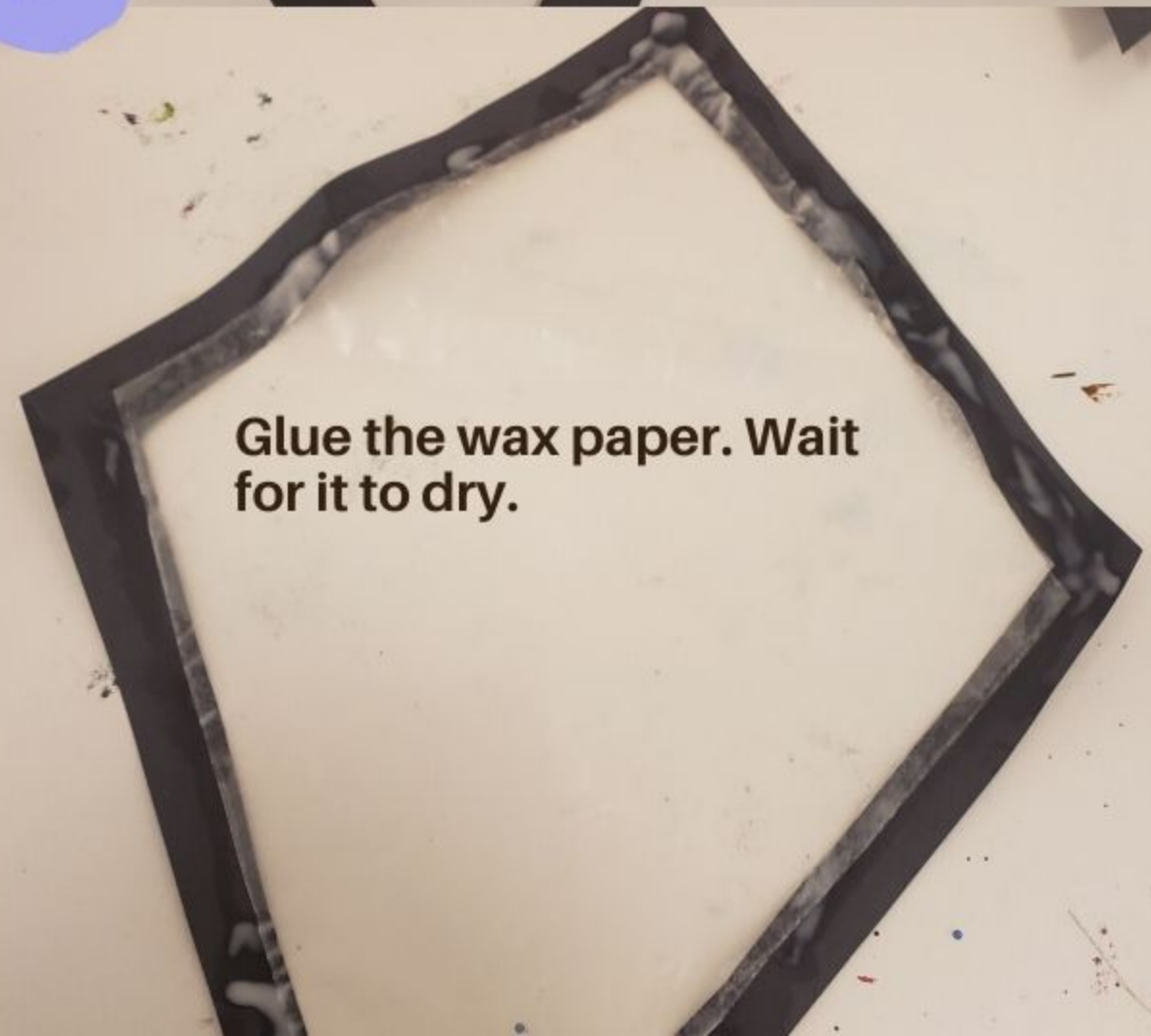

Use your pencil to trace the kite & then cut the diamond out of the wax paper.

Glue the wax paper. Wait for it to dry.



Kite Sun Catcher Part 2



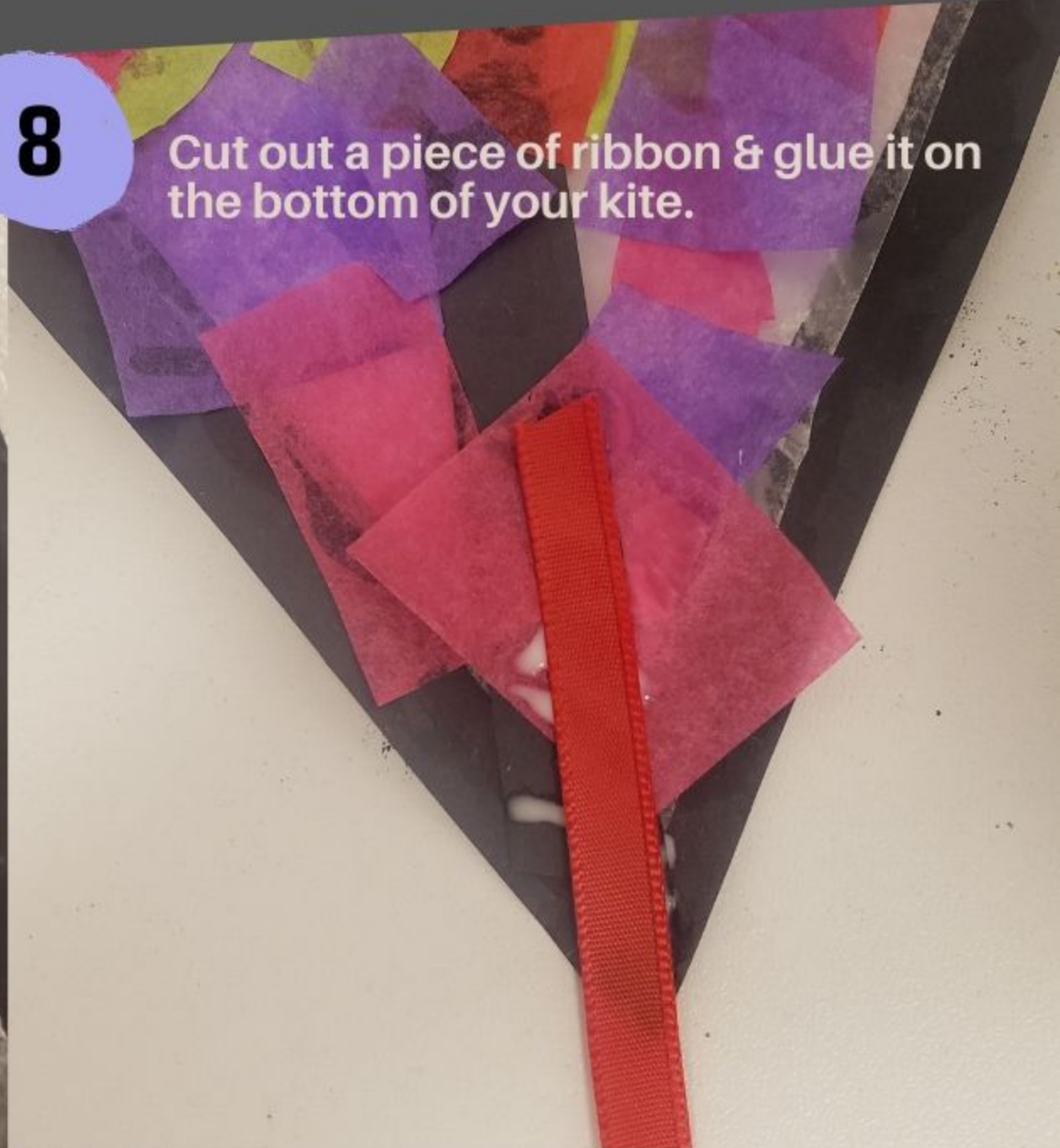

Cut out multiple squares from the tissue paper & glue them all over wax paper.

Cut out a piece of ribbon & glue it on the bottom of your kite.



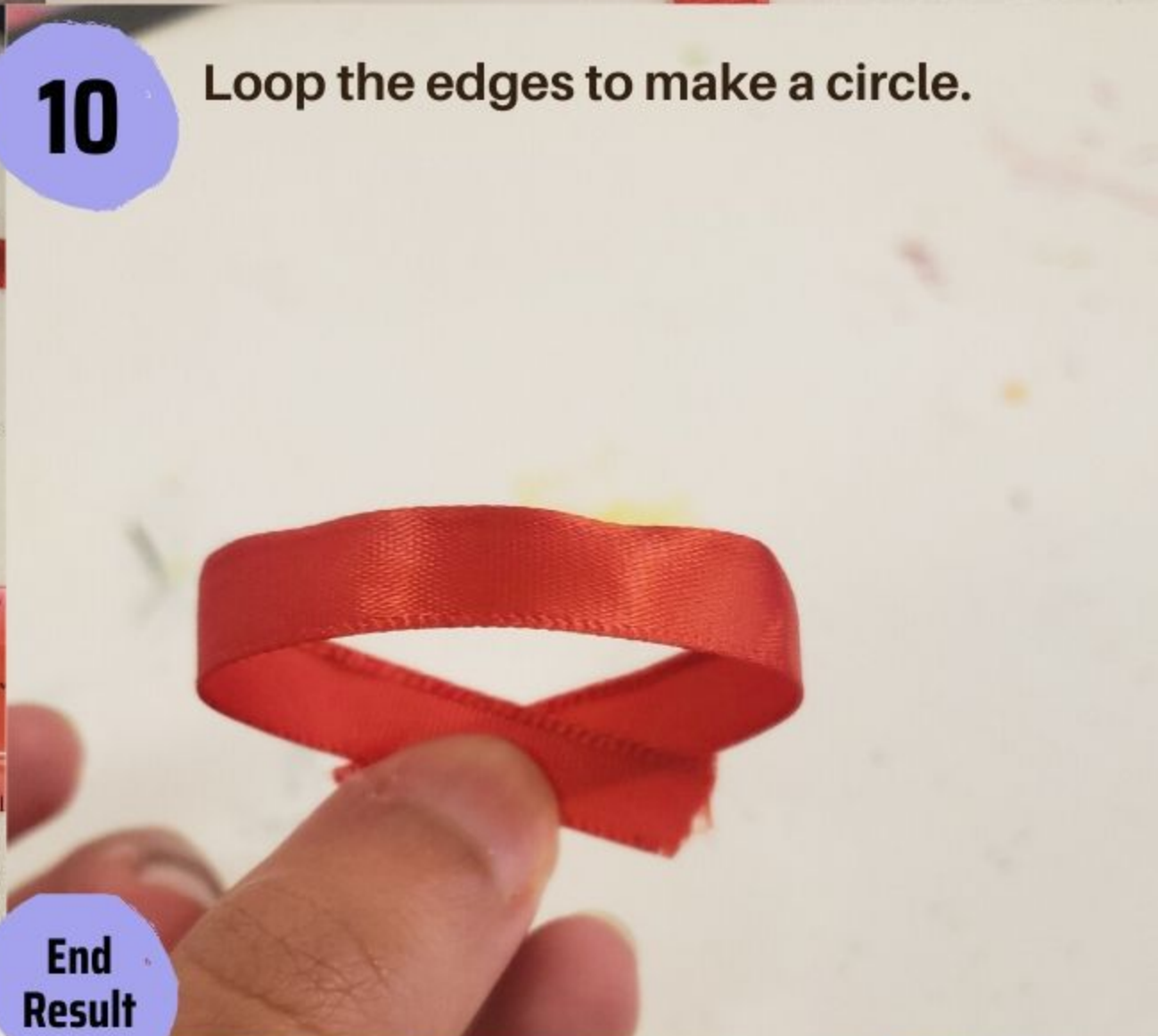

Measure another ribbon to be 8.5 inches.

Loop the edges to make a circle.

Press your thumb down on the top of the circle. The circle should reshape itself into a bow.



Hold the bow by the edge & carefully staple the area where the ribbons intersect.

Glue the bow onto the ribbon. Repeat the process to add multiple bows.

End Result



Tape your kite onto your window & you're done!
