Paper Castle Tutorial Part 1

- Materials:
- Glue
 - Scissors
 - Pencil
 - Markers
 - White, red & brown construction paper

2

Fold the white paper in half twice.

3

Unfold the paper. It should look like this.

4

Close your paper. Cut two lines into the paper. Move the extra paper up & cut it off.

5

This is the shape you will have once removing the excess paper in the middle. Repeat the same cut several times.

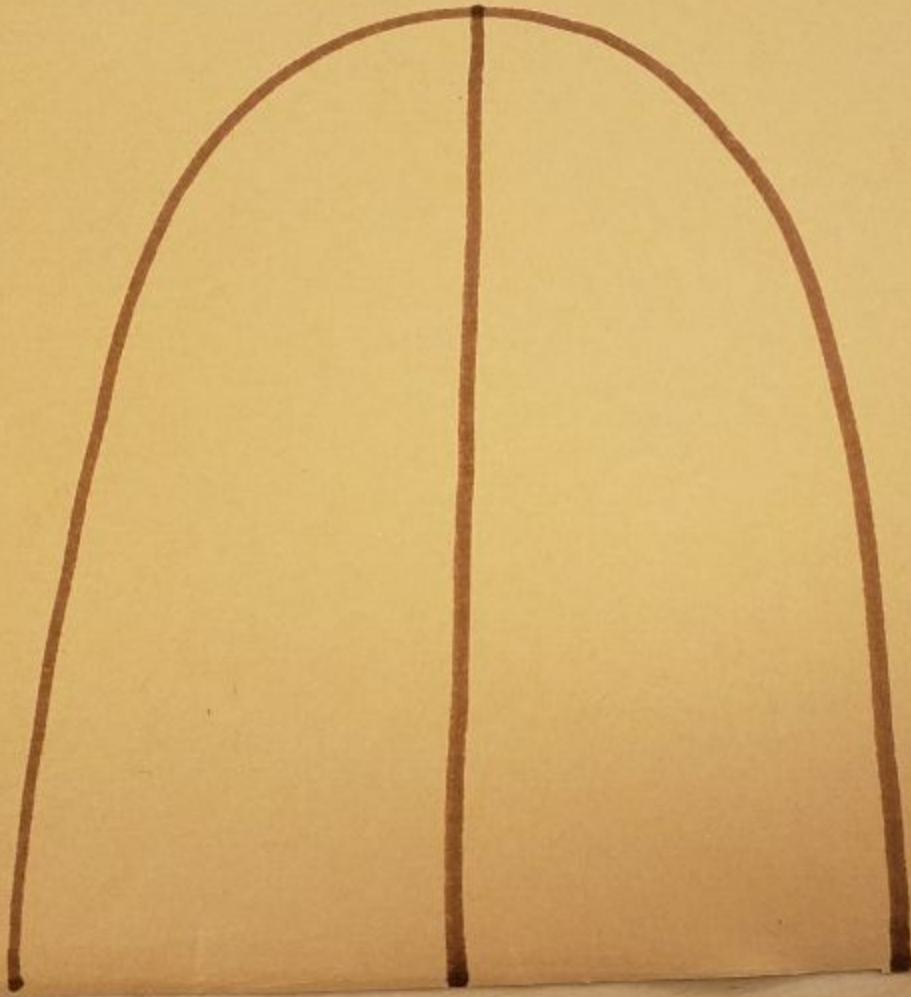

Now you'll have a completed set of crenels on top. You've probably seen this style of architecture on medieval castles

7 Draw a large door on the brown paper. This will be the door to your castle.



8 Cut the shapes out. Make sure to cut through the middle. Glue these shapes onto your castle.



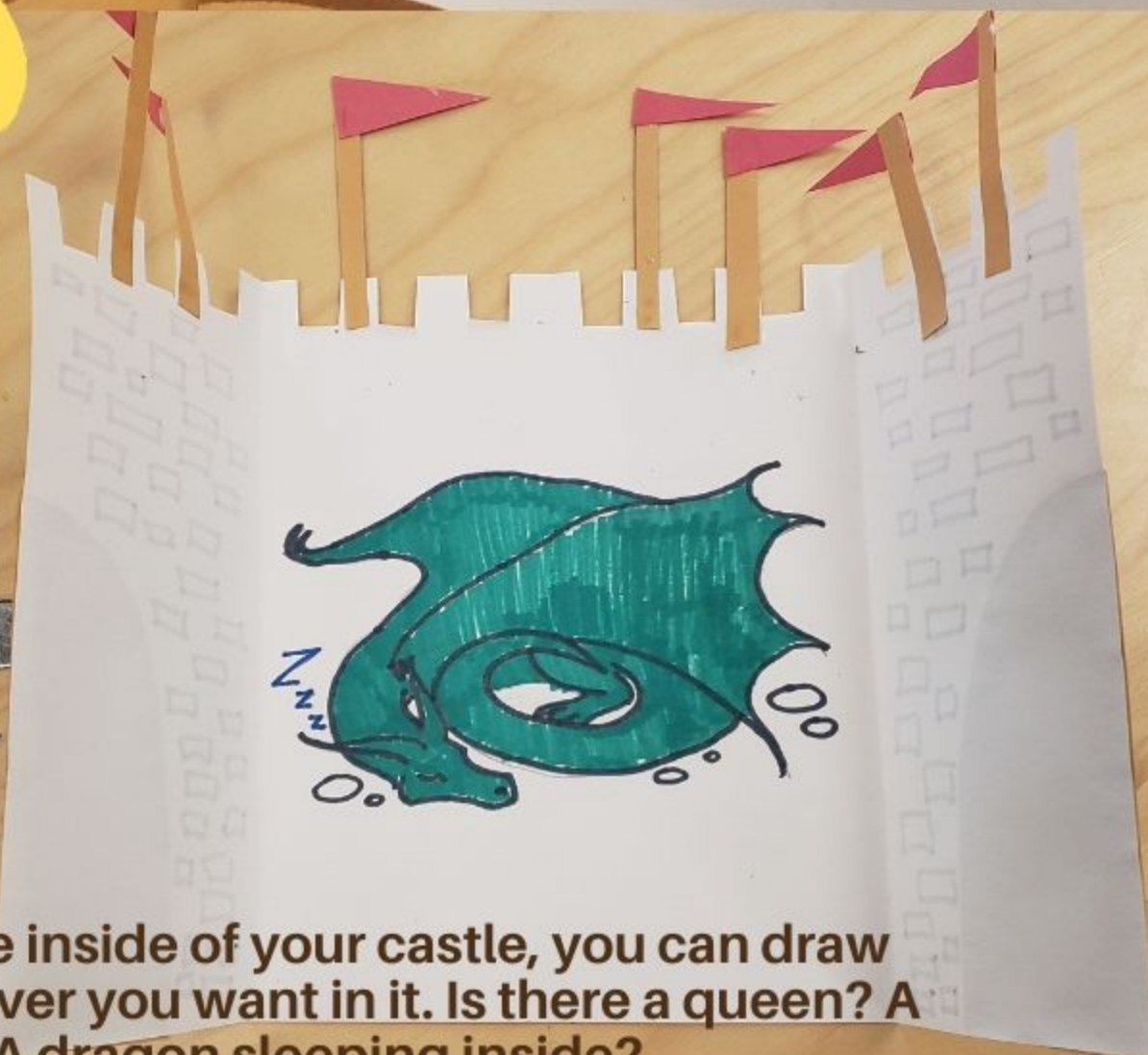
Next, use your marker to draw bricks all over your castle.

10 Cut out a thin rectangle. Cut a triangle out & glue the triangle onto the rectangle.



Add some glue to the bottom of the flag pole & place it on your castle. You'll want to make multiple flags.

For the inside of your castle, you can draw whatever you want in it. Is there a queen? A king? A dragon sleeping inside?
