## Tillamook County Fair Pavilion Riding Permit Rates and Rules 503-842-2272

Riding permits are required by any and all persons riding a horse on the Tillamook County Fairgrounds. Permits are issued per person, not per horse.

## Rates:

Riding permits will not be prorated by the day, purchases are full month/season or after the 15<sup>th</sup> rate shown above. There are no refunds on riding permits.

Season is mid September through June each year.

One riding permit is provided to each stall renter at no additional charge.

Riding is permitted in the Pavilion and outdoor Averill arena only. Riding hours are between 8 a.m. and 8 p.m., Sunday through Saturday. No open riding is permitted when an event or activity is scheduled in the above areas. Monopolizing of the facilities during open riding is not allowed by any individual or group.

The Fairgrounds can be busy with events throughout the year. We will attempt to post and/or notify riders of any closures in a timely manner. This will allow permit holders to plan around scheduled activities. The Fair reserves the right to book events at any time and are subject to change without advance notice. Calendars will be posted in the Pavilion and in the Fair Office, when available.

<u>Rules:</u> These are general rules and are subject to change without notice. Any matter not expressly provided for shall rest solely within the discretion of the Tillamook County Fair Board or Manager.

- 1. Individuals using the Pavilion shall enter through the South gate off of Brookfield Road.
- 2. Dogs are NOT allowed on the Fairgrounds at any time. If you need ADA accommodations, please contact the Fair office.
- Speed limit on the Fairgrounds is 5 mph. This must be strictly followed for the safety of all patrons and animals on the grounds.
- 4. Parking is allowed in designated areas only; West of the Pavilion.
- 5. No loose or unattended horses are allowed. Horses may be tied to designated areas only. Trees, panels, pens, signs, garbage cans, etc. are not acceptable places to tie horses.
- 6. It is your responsibility to clean up your area before leaving the fairgrounds. Please dispose of any excess hay and all manure. Pick up any trash and dispose in containers provided.
- Cleaning of horse trailers must be in designated areas only, and all manure must be disposed of at the manure slab.
  Cleanouts are NOT allowed in any parking areas. Any person cleaning horse trailers, or leaving debris on roadways will have riding permit revoked.
- 8. Riding is permitted in the Pavilion and outdoor Averill Arena (when available) only. Riders and horses who do not currently rent stalls on the fairgrounds are NOT allowed in the stable area Southeast of the Pavilion. For additional safety reasons, riders and horses are not allowed beyond the Northeast corner of the Pavilion.

- 9. Riding permit must be displayed at all times while on the grounds. If you are found letting others in to ride for free, or sharing the gate code with others, your own pass will be revoked.
- 10. It is your responsibility to make sure that your horse has the necessary vaccinations and in good health while on the Fairgrounds property. This is a public facility with many horses/animals using them at any time.
- 11. There are no refunds for lost permits.

## 12. Anyone under 18 years of age MUST wear a helmet while riding or handling a horse while on Tillamook County Fairgrounds Property.

This is an EQUINE FACILITY. All activities on these grounds are subject to the Equine Inherent Risk Law (ORS 30.687-30.697). By your presence on these grounds you have indicated that you have accepted the limits of liability resulting from inherent risks of equine activities.

The permittee does expressly agree to indemnify and hold the Tillamook County Fair Board <u>AND</u> Tillamook County, its officers, agents, servants, and employees harmless from any and all claims, demands, loss, damages, injury, costs, attorneys' fees, expenses, causes of action, judgments, penalties, (contractual or otherwise) or liability of whatsoever nature and howsoever the same may be caused or may arise resulting directly or indirectly from the exercise of the Use Permit or the occupation of the premises herein permitted to be used or the premises of the Tillamook County Fair, to which the permittee, its agents, employees or lessees may have access by reason of this license.

UNDER OREGON LAW, NO PERSON SHALL BE LIABLE FOR DAMAGES SUSTAINTED BY ANOTHER AS A RESULT OF RISKS INHERENT IN EQUINE ACTIVITIY, IN SO FAR AS THOSE RISKS ARE, OR SHOULD BE, REASONABLY OBVIOUS, EXPECTED OR NECESSARY TO THE PERSON INJURED. ORS 30.689
