Annual Board Meeting Held in March


Updates and Improvements Heard by Members

Exposition Begins New Year With Honors

TAF&E Convention full of Highlights for the Expo

The Amarillo Tri-State Exposition made headlines during the annual Texas Association of Fairs & Events Convention in Austin, January 12-15. The TAF&E Convention bestows numerous

awards and honors during the event and the Exposition brought their fair share back to Amarillo.

Former manager of the Exposition Lynn Griffin was inducted into the Hall of Fame. Griffin who now lives in Nashville, Tenn., was joined by two of his daughters and a granddaughter at the Saturday luncheon.

Griffin is a US Army veteran, and has served the Texas Fair industry since the 1950s when he was recruited by the Austin Chamber to manage their agriculture department. His career has included stints at the Austin Livestock Show and San Antonio Livestock Show before managing the Tri-State Fair & Rodeo for 17 years.

Current general manager of the Exposition Virgil Bartlett was *surprised* to learn that he was the recipient of the Manager/Professional of the Year award.

During Bartlett's 10-year tenure with the fair, he is credited with removing or replacing all antiquated structures, increasing profitability and building financial re-

serves. He has served on numerous TAF&E committees and is the current TAF&E secretary/ assistant treasurer.

Marketing awards were awarded Saturday morning prior to the luncheon honoring Griffin and Bartlett. The Exposition brought home 12 awards for the 2011 fair and rodeo campaign. First place award categories are: Outdoor Advertising, Best Green/Environmental Program (Xcel Energy grant), Newspaper Ad-Color and Flyer/Brochure-3 or Fewer Colors. Second place honors include: Media Guide/Press Kit, Photograph Series, Premium Book, Newspaper Insert/Supplement and Newsletter. Third place honors: Radio Promotion, New Media Platform and TV Promotion.

The Exposition competes in the category of fairs and events in Texas that have an attendance of 100,001-500,000 in attendance.




