NEEDLE ARTS DISPLAYS

LIMITED TO TULARE COUNTY RESIDENTS

1. In classes calling for original design, no stamped patterns are allowed. They must be of your own design, not just a change of fabric or color in published direction or kit.
2. All hanging articles must be ready to hang or they will not be accepted for judging. Use wire for pictures. Pictures must be framed, stretched, or mounted.
3. Pillows must be finished on back and have pillow inside.
4. Quilts must be complete and made by hand unless otherwise specified. Binding may be machine stitched on the inside but must be attached by hand.
5. Rugs shall not exceed 6 feet in width and 9 feet in length; Round rugs shall not exceed 9 feet in diameter. "Any Other" category is for items NOT listed.
6. Design size is determined by actual 'stitched' area - frame or material size.
7. The exhibitor must have produced all entries in the department within one (1) year of the opening day of the fair, quilts excluded.
8. Imported or manufactured articles are prohibited from competing for awards.
9. Exhibits must be adequately and correctly labeled, clean and pressed

1. Professional is defined as anyone who has received \$500.00 or more in any one year for: teaching quilting, quilting skills, or quilting for others.
2. Quilt must have been completed during the prior two (2) years and may not have been previously entered in the Tulare County Fair.
3. A MINIMUM 3" SLEEVE MUST be attached to each quilt for hanging purposes. Miniature quilts must have either sleeves or loops attached and it is recommended that exhibitors supply dowel(s) for display purposes.
4. **SPECIFY SIZE AND PATTERN ON ONLINE ENTRY FORM.**
5. Exhibitor must cover all signage of any type in masking tape for judging purpose.

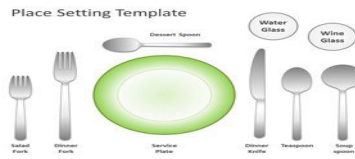

PRESERVED FOODS

OPEN TO TULARE COUNTY RESIDENTS

1. Bring one (1) container per entry; for judging and display indoors.
2. All entries must be home prepared and canned or packaged by the exhibitor within one year prior to the opening date of the Fair. Items that have been shown at any previous Fair are not eligible.
3. STANDARD CANNING JARS TO BE USED (glass, any size) MASON, BALL, OR ANY OTHER STANDARD CANNING JAR. Jars of the mayonnaise, coffee, pickle, or peanut butter type are not acceptable. Any entries submitted in such types will be disqualified.
4. **PARAFFIN SEALED ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.**
5. Non-acid foods and all vegetables must be canned under pressure. Low acid fruits, such as figs, should be made more acid by adding lemon juice, as directed in the University of California Agricultural Extension Service leaflet, Home Canning of Fruits. Tomatoes and fruits (not including their juices) must be processed in a boiling water bath. Items will not necessarily be taste-tested, appearance and texture is most important!
6. All canning items must have new rings, and each jar must be labeled with name of item.
7. **Please specify if canning with no salt added, no sugar added, or any artificial sweetener added.**
8. **LIMIT: 4 Entries per Exhibitor per class.**
9. **OPENED JARS MUST BE PICKED UP MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 19 from 10:00AM –5:00PM OR BE DISCARDED.**
