Judging and Award Information

The judge shall award first, second, or third place, according to merit. The Danish System will be used in the basic evaluation of exhibits in classes 1-5. Each entry is judged on its own merit. Entries are placed first (90 points or better), second (89-80 points) and third (79 points or lower).

Premium money may be added, depending on sponsorships
