INDEPENDENT JUNIOR LIVESTOCK EXHIBITOR CHECKLIST

- Contact fair office NO LATER THAN March 1st** to notify fair that you plan on exhibiting at the fair as an Independent Exhibitor
- All independent exhibitors must maintain a fair provided Independent Record Book; record books can be obtained from the fair office or online at tbvfair.com
- Exhibitor and Leader/Parent must attend three independent exhibitor meetings throughout the year prior to the 2024 Tulelake Butte Valley Fair. The fair staff will give you a record log when you attend your first meeting.
- All Independent Exhibitors must attend a Quality Assurance Training Class or take the online class each year.
- Complete entry forms and pay entry fees by the entry deadline www.tbvfair.com.
- Attend the required pre weigh-in and tagging for your specie of animal. Beef in early May, Sheep/Swine/Goats in early July. Dates and times will be announced in March.
- Independent exhibitors are required to perform 6 hours of community service, within the year of the fair that they plan on exhibiting at. Complete the Community Service form to turn in with your record book.
- Independent Livestock exhibitors must turn in a **completed** record book to the fair office in order to be eligible to participate in the Tulelake Butte Valley Fair. Record Books are due the Monday prior to fair.
