# 10-A DISTRICT AGRICULTURAL ASSOCIATION – TULELAKE-BUTTE VALLEY FAIR Board of Director Meeting Minutes -Approved WEDNESDAY JULY 31<sup>ST</sup>, 2024

<u>CALL TO ORDER:</u> The 10A District Agricultural Association Board of Directors meeting was called to order by President Angela Sutton at 6:06 pm and was held in the fair office conference room in Tulelake, CA.

  - Logistics are being discussed as to re-organizing the area/setup: They discussed making the auction ring smaller.
  - o Rotary will be mailing out a schedule of events and the livestock schedule is online

#### **Advisory Committees**

- <u>Jr. Fair Board Committee:</u> Directors Fine and Sutton reported on Jr. Fair Board. Meeting will be August 28<sup>th</sup>, 2024 at the IREC center. All members on the JR. Fair board must either enter an animal, or enter a still exhibit. Director Fine asked if we could check in with Paul to see about getting them wristbands. Jr. Fair board Committee Directors will check to see who is eligible to receive one based on their bylaws. Directors Sutton and Fine will look into Fair board Members going to Friday Fest at Butte Valley to have a booth to sell items. Director Fine let the Megan know that some Jr. Fair board members were supposed to be meeting with her to get vendor information for the Mr. Potato Head hunt.

- Fundraiser Committee:
  - Casino Night—Megan will be out of office from October 1<sup>st</sup>-January 1<sup>st</sup>. We need to start
    purchasing our big ticket items when we see them on clearance. We liked using the individual
    bags for tickets instead of the hopper. We need to try to find more "stays"/Vacation and event
    items for the event.
- <u>Parade Committee:</u> Grand Marshalls have been chosen as Shirl & Chuck Woodson. The committee will look into what they will ride in as well as the Fair Queen.

#### **Business Report and Information:**

#### Administration & Maintenance:

• **Telecommunications:** Cal-Ore has sent over a quote/agreement for updating Wi-Fi and telecommunication infastructure. Director Sutton wanted to meet with them to see what all the fees were for and to get clarification on the agreement before we sign. Questions to be asked: How long is this agreement for? What is

the cost breakdown for each component of the agreement? Nancy will work on setting up a meeting with Rodney.

- **Saffire Order for Admissions:** Equipment needs to be ordered for Admissions. Discussion was held about finding additional options for getting these items to save money.
- **Fairtime Parking:** We are selling VIP parking passes this year in a limited quantity. We also have vendor parking available to help free up more general parking spaces. We are also looking into some different types of barricades to block off certain areas.
- **Bathroom:** The men's bathroom in the Home Ec. building still needs fixing. The wall will need some type of temporary covering to hold us over until we can do a remodel of the building. We are having a difficult time getting contractors to call us back and commit to dates/times.
- **Ticketing:** Discussion was held about finding a vendor in Butte Valley to sell some of the Golden Tickets at. This might be the Gas Station, or the Coffee Trailer.
- **Advertising:** Posters for the fair are coming soon. We have ordered the still exhibit books and will need to get some livestock ones ordered once the board votes on any changes.
- **Entertainment:** The board mentioned that we need a balloon artist. Megan has been seeking out other local options for this as most of the balloon artists have already been hired. We have decided on not having an event on Sunday night this year.

#### **Old Business:**

- Department Assistants: Director Sutton explained to guest what Department Assistants were and their function.
- We need to assign all committees.
- Livestock Superintendent explained the Livestock Rule Changes that she proposed we make.
  - o Sale Order—Grand and Reserve to sell first and then the rest of the species will be selected randomly.
- Rotary President let us know that a community member-Whitney King will help with the sale order.

#### **New Business:**

- November Meeting: Discuss entertainment and Alcohol Policy.
- Red Ribbon Rule—Livestock Superintendent held a discussion on removing the use of Red Ribbons.
- Voting on Sale Order Changes.

Director Sutton moved to approve the change in Sale Order to state that Champion and Reserve will sell first and all other entries in that species will be placed in random order. Director Luscombe seconded the motion. 4 were in favor, 1 was not—motion passed.
