# Reining

## NRHA 5

Horses may walk or trot to the center of arena.

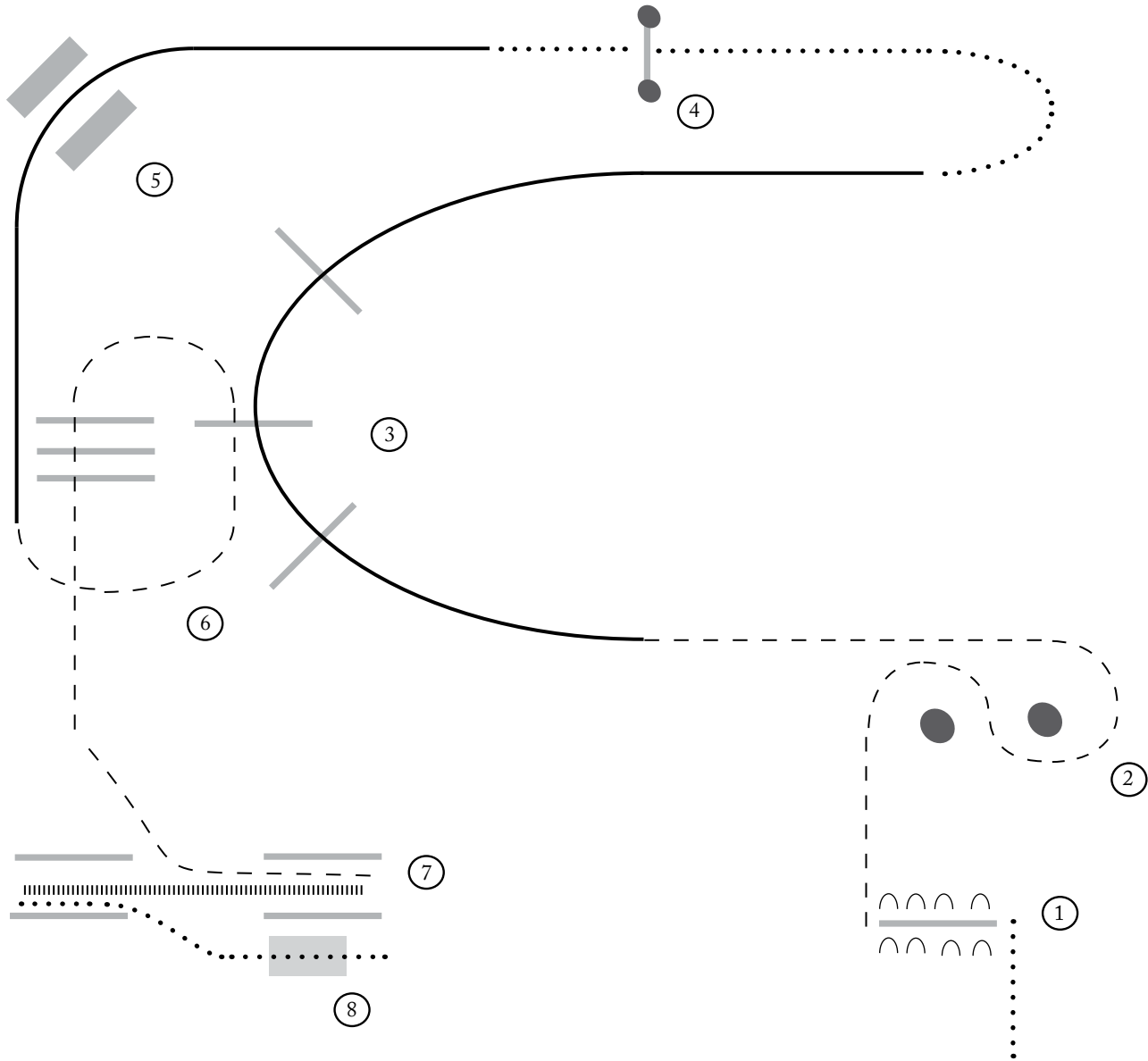
Horses must walk or stop prior to starting pattern.

Beginning at the center of the arena facing the left wall or fence.

1. Beginning on the left lead, complete three circles to the left: the first two circles large and fast; the third circle small and slow. Stop at the center of the arena. Hesitate.
2. Complete four spins to the left. Hesitate.
3. Beginning on the right lead, complete three circles to the right: the first two circles large and fast; the third circle small and slow. Stop at the center of the arena. Hesitate.
4. Complete four spins to the right. Hesitate.
5. Beginning on the left lead, run a large fast circle to the left, change leads at the center of the arena, run a large fast circle to the right, and change leads at the center of the arena.
6. Continue around previous circle to the left but do not close this circle. Run up the right side of the arena past the center marker and do a right roll back at least twenty feet (six meters) from the wall or fence – no hesitation.
7. Continue around previous circle but do not close this circle. Run up the left side of the arena past the center marker and do a left rollback at least twenty feet (six meters) from the wall or fence – no hesitation.
8. Continue back around previous circle but do not close this circle. Run up the right side of the arena past the center marker and do a sliding stop at least twenty feet (six meters) from the wall or fence. Back up at least ten feet (three meters). Hesitate to demonstrate completion of the pattern.

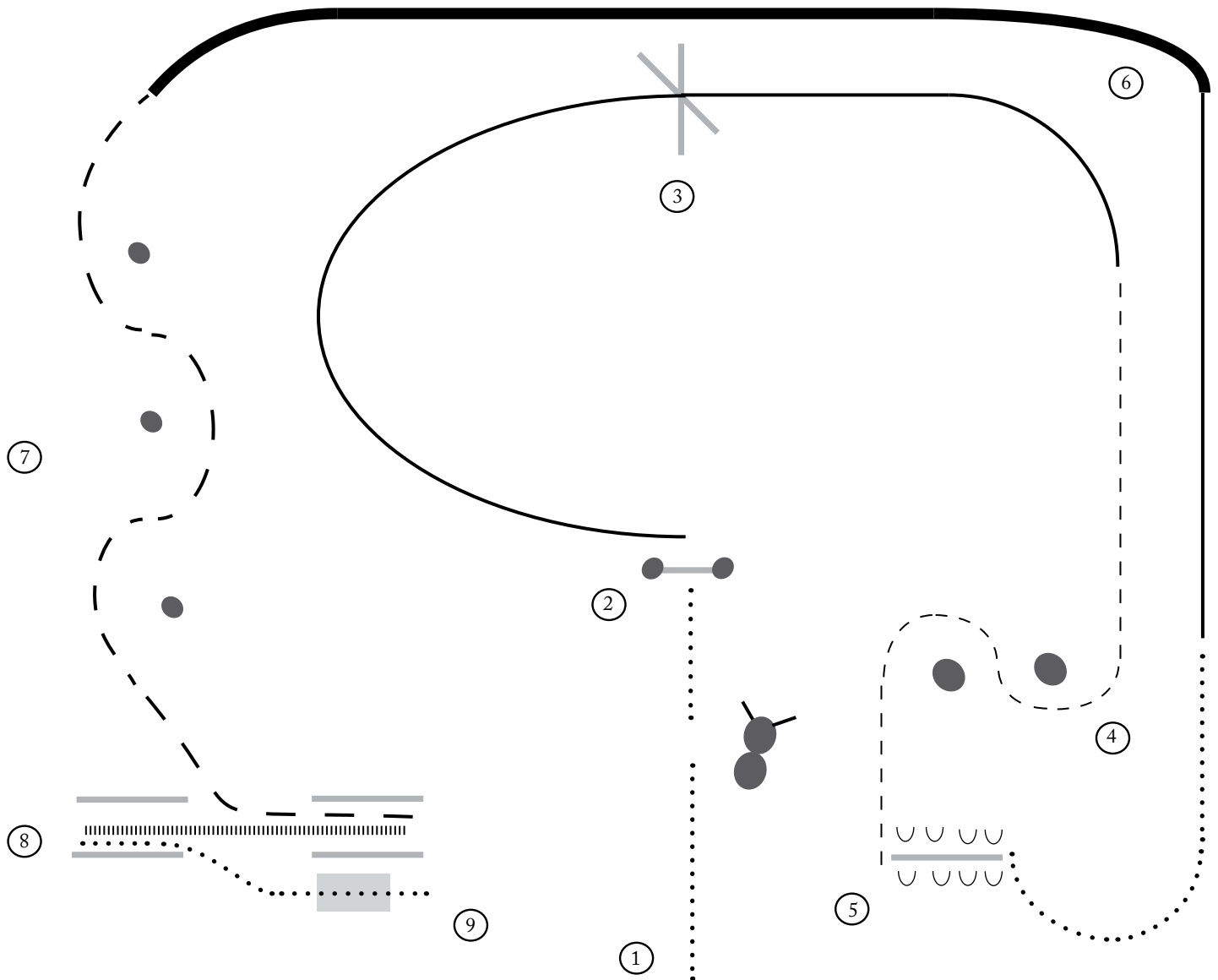


1. Walk to pole, stop, sidepass left over pole
2. Jog serpentine
3. Lope, right lead, over poles
4. Walk to gate, work gate, right hand, walk away from gate
5. Lope, left lead, through chute
6. Jog over poles and into chute
7. Stop, back
8. Walk out of chute and over bridge

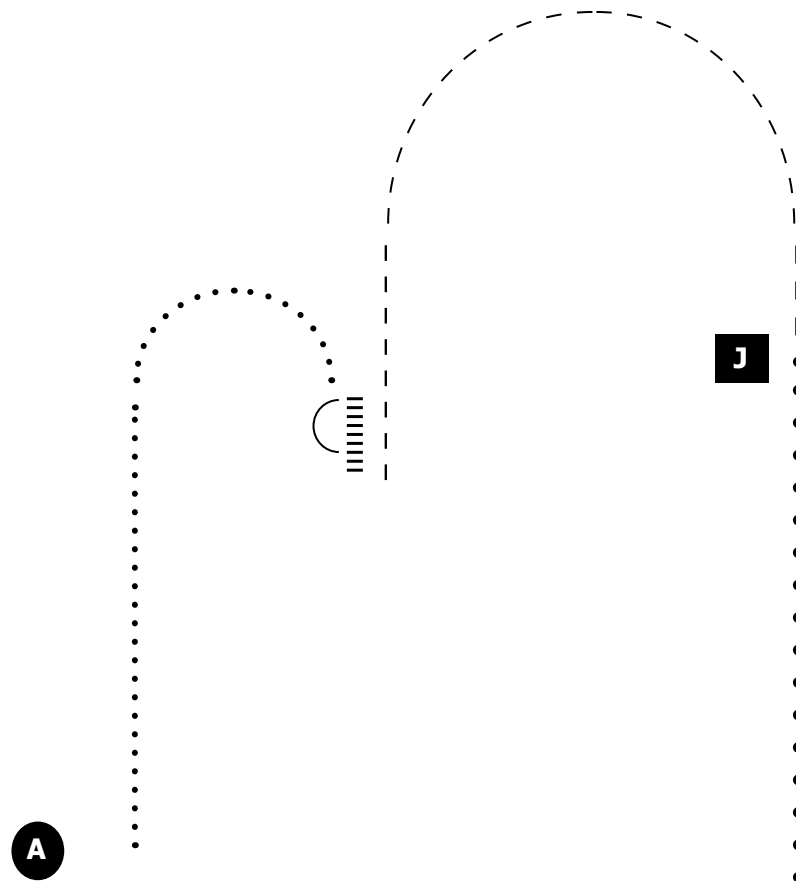
1. Walk in with rope in hand, walk to dummy, stop, rope dummy, drop rope after one throw

6. Walk, lope, left lead, extend lope
7. Extended trot serpentine and into chute
8. Stop, back
9. Walk out of chute and over bridge to exit

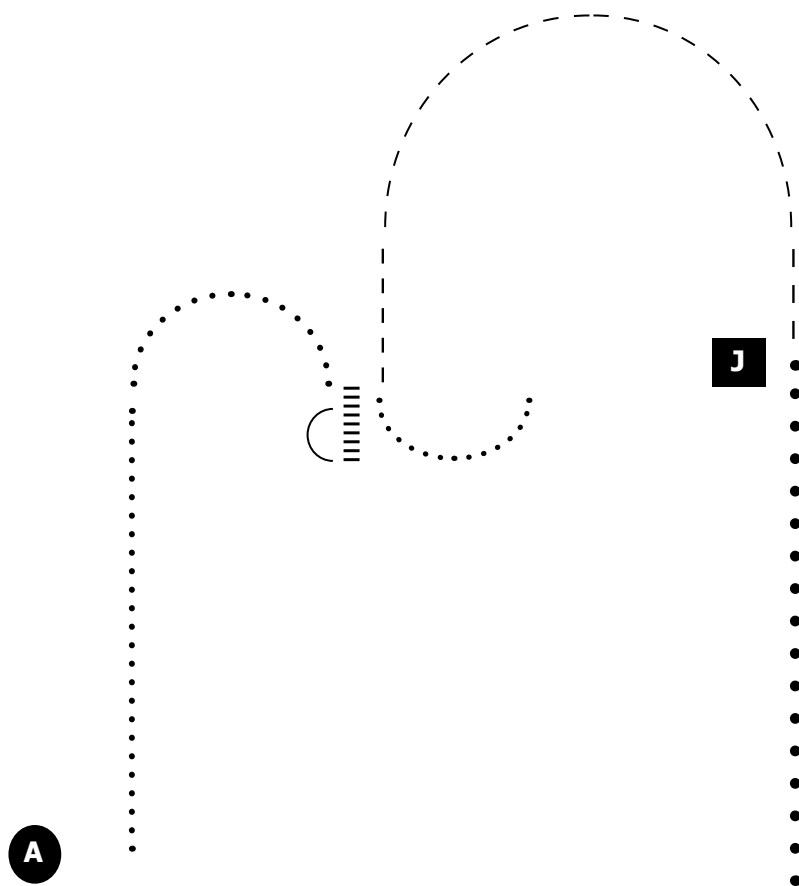

4. Ground tie - drop lead, walk in front of horse to off side then back to near side - gather lead.
5. Trot half circle and stop when Judge is on right side of horse
6. Lower the horses head briefly then present horse to Judge
7. Answer question from Judge
8. Extended walk to exit
