

2022 Nomination Checklist

Complete checklist before returning nomination materials

- Read Nomination Rules and Guidelines.
- Animals required to submit nomination: market steers, commercial heifers, market barrows, breeding gilts, market lambs, commercial ewes, meat goats & breeding does.
- DNA kits must be ordered by June 23. DNA kits include DNA envelope and Tulsa tag.
- Make sure you tag the animal(s) with a tag assigned to that specie:
 - Cattle Tags are ORANGE
 - Goat, Sheep & Swine Tags are PINK
- Submit exhibitor and animal information online **by 5pm on July 1**
 - Every animal nominated must have nomination information submitted online.
 - If family nominating, each animal must be nominated online in each siblings name.
 - Mail a copy of exhibitor(s) online receipt with the DNA sample.
- Make sure DNA hair envelope includes the following:
 - 40 hairs with follicles intact
 - Correct Tulsa Tag Number corresponding with the DNA sample in the envelope
 - Signature of **all exhibitors**, parent, CEA or FFA Instructor, and collector
 - Make sure to completely seal the envelope
- Family Nominations:
 - Only one DNA envelope per animal is required.
 - All exhibitors' (siblings) names and signatures must be on DNA sample envelope.
 - Enter each exhibitor online and every animal in each exhibitor's name. Online receipt required for each sibling showing the animal nominated.
 - The primary exhibitor will not be chosen at nomination time. The final exhibitor decision will be made at the time of entry.
- Online nomination receipt must be mailed with DNA envelopes.
(Do not staple receipt to the DNA envelope.)
- Photo requirement for steer exhibitors:
 - Upload three photos of the steer online: front view, right, and left side profile.
 - Crossbred steers do not need to submit photos.
- Exhibitors should maintain a copy of the nomination receipt.
- DNA envelope and copy of online receipt must **be postmarked by July 1**. Mail to:

- Nominations will be processed and posted on the Tulsa State Fair website in mid July. Please review all of your nominations and inform the Livestock Office of any corrections prior to August 1.
