DIVISION RULES

- Ownership:** Sheep must be owned by exhibitor prior to July 1, 2021. The management reserves the right to pen animals as space permits. Entries will be accepted in order received. The management therefore, reserves the right to reject entries when housing capacity is reached. Only those breeds mentioned will compete. All others will be considered display animals. Exhibitors carrying extra animals must make arrangements for housing elsewhere.
- Breeds Offered:** Hair, Natural, Shropshire, Southdown, Dorset, Dorset Advantage, Hampshire & Suffolk
- Check In:** All sheep will need to be checked in by the superintendent by 8 am on Friday, October 2. Original registration papers are required at check in. It shall be the responsibility of each exhibitor to be certain his or her animals are entered in the proper class prior to show time. Once the show begins there will be no substitutions, changes or alterations.
- Registration Papers:** All entries must be registered and recorded by recognized breed associations in the name of the exhibitor. Only original registration papers will be accepted by the Tulsa State Fair. Failure to submit registration papers at check in by the specified time will result in disqualification of animal from show.
- Tattoos & Tags:** Flocktags, tattoos, and/or registry association tags must be in the ears of all animals.
- Fungus Inspection:** All sheep will be checked for fungus during check in. Blankets must be removed. Any sheep with fungus confirmed will be asked to leave the grounds.
- Presentation of Sheep:** All sheep, display and competition, must be presented in "Show Condition." Sheep must be washed, trimmed and fitted with the exception of: Southdown sheep, Shropshire sheep and any classes designated as Slickshorn must be sheared completely within 2 weeks of the show. Shropshire sheep will be allowed to shear according to the American Shropshire Registry breed standards. If animals entered do not meet these criteria, they will be disqualified.
- Pens:** Pens will be first come, first serve unless assigned by superintendent. All pens and alleys must be cleaned before 8 am each day. Blocking of the aisles for the purpose of eliminating spectator traffic is strictly prohibited.
- Exhibitor's Flock:** Shall consist of one ram, any age; two yearling ewes; and two ewe lambs.
- Premier Exhibitor:** Shall be the exhibitor winning the most premium money in individual classes within each breed. Ties will be broken by the highest group placing.
- Grooming Equipment:** Blocking tables, show rails, and/or head chutes will be allowed, but must be used in stall only.
- Grooming:** Painting the animals hooves is acceptable; however any evidence of any dye, powder, paint or other artificial color (alteration or additive), will be grounds for disqualification of that animal and exhibitor.
- Premiums:** 1st - \$40, 2nd - \$30, 3rd - \$20, 4th - \$10
