49.	Get-of-Sire	Four animals shown in individual classes with both sexes represented and all the progeny of one sire. It is permissible to use either the cow or calf from a cow/calf pair. May be comprised of animals from one or more owners.	Rosette
50.	Best Six Head	All animals must have been shown in individual classes and they must be owned by the exhibitor or by a member of his immediate family. A cow/calf will be considered as two head in the Best Six Head class.	Rosette
