DIVISION RULES

1. The Texas Longhorn World Qualifying Show is open to cattle registered with the Texas Longhorn Breeders Association of America (TLBAA), PO Box 4430, Fort Worth, TX 76164.
2. Exhibitors are subject to all rules and regulations of the Tulsa State Fair and the TLBAA. The signing of the entry form by the exhibitor implies agreement to abide by all the rules and regulations governing the TLBAA World Show Circuit as stated in the TLBAA World Show Circuit Official Handbook. Copies of the rules and regulations can be obtained from the at the above address or at www.tlbba.org. Any person found guilty of misrepresentation or not abiding by the show rules will be disqualified from showing.
3. All animals, except calves beside dam, must be registered with the TLBAA and a copy of the original registration certificate must be presented to the superintendent for verification prior to the show. No pending registrations will be accepted.
4. All bulls are required to be shown with a nose lead (permanent nose ring if 12 months of age or older).
5. Exhibitors must wear western attire, long sleeve shirt or long sleeve blouse with collar and cuffs and pants or skirt with boots, while exhibiting cattle in the show ring.
6. The Tulsa State Fair will furnish \$5,700 of the premium money and the Oklahoma Texas Longhorn Association will furnish \$1,500 of the premium money.

2. All youth must be members in good standing with the Texas Longhorn Breeders of Tomorrow (TLBT). Exhibitors are subject to all rules and regulations of the Tulsa State Fair, TLBAA and the TLBT. The signing of the entry form by the exhibitor implies agreement to abide by all the rules and regulations governing the TLBT World Show Circuit as stated in the TLBAA World Show Circuit Official Handbook. Copies of the rules and regulations can be obtained from the TLBAA, at the above address, or at www.tlbaa.org. Any person found guilty of misrepresentation or not abiding by the show rules will be disqualified from showing.
3. All animals, except calves beside dam, must be registered with the TLBAA and a copy of the original registration certificate must be presented to the superintendent for verification prior to the show. No pending registrations will be accepted.
4. All bulls are required to be shown with a nose lead (permanent nose ring if 12 months of age or older).
5. Note Miniature Steers: Animal must be registered as a miniature Texas Longhorn steer and have the "M" notation in their registration number. Miniature Steers must adhere to miniature height requirements of 50" at the hook bone at three years of age.
6. Exhibitors must wear western attire, long sleeve shirt or long sleeve blouse with collar and cuffs and pants or skirt with boots, while exhibiting cattle in the show ring.

Showmanship Classifications

Pee Wee: EXHIBITION CLASS: Youth six years and younger may show calves, male or female. This is the only class that will allow adults in the show ring.

Division I: Junior Showmanship. Exhibitors 7-9 years of age as of January 1, 2024.

Division II: Intermediate Showmanship. Exhibitors 10-12 years of age as of January 1, 2024.

Division III: Teen Showmanship. Exhibitors 13-15 years of age as of January 1, 2024.

Division IV: Senior Showmanship: Exhibitors 16-18 years of age as of January 1, 2024. The top age limit for the Senior Division will be 18 years or the year of graduation from high school. (Seniors may not show following the National Show the year of their graduation.)

In Showmanship Classes youth must exhibit an animal that was shown in competition in the TLBT Show.
