Year To Date 2022: COMMUNITY IMPACT

The United Wireless Arena and Boot Hill Casino & Resort Conference Center, managed by VenuWorks, was established with the goal to bring a positive impact on the surrounding community - both economically and to enhance the quality of life by providing entertainment through sporting events, music concerts, comedic acts, and family-friendly events as well as a conference space in the heart of Kansas and the southwest. The Arena and Conference Center has a huge impact on the surrounding community with each and every event. Guests coming to conferences, shows, or sporting events spend money in the surrounding community for hotel rooms, restaurants, at gas stations and shopping. So far, in 2022 United Wireless Arena and the Boot Hill Casino & Resort Conference Center has brought a combined Economic Impact of approximately **\$8,040,240*** to the Dodge City area with estimated attendance of **89,336****!
