- ❖ Trash must be disposed of in available trash cans or removed from property upon your departure.
- ❖ A designated unloading and parking area for Vendors will be located next to the Pavilion.

- ❖ **Applications and Booth Space fees must be received at the Uvalde County Fairplex Management Office no later than Thursday, July 1, 2021**
- ❖ No refund of booth space payment once application has been processed.
- ❖ All proceeds will go to the Uvalde Volunteer Fire Department for the purchase of fireworks for 2022.
