ImOn Ice (formerly Cedar Rapids Ice Arena) opened in 2001, and in 2014 the McGrath Amphitheatre opened and was added to the VenuWorks management.





Attendance by Events Type





- ImOn Ice Arena, formally known as the Cedar Rapids Ice Arena, has been a staple in the Cedar Rapids Community for over 20 years.
- The city of Cedar Rapids invested \$6 million in the repair and renovation of the arena after significant damage from the 2020 derecho. The venue was able to reopen fully in July of 2021 for community users, national championship events and a full USHL season. When the Roughrider season began in October, it was the first time in 595 days.









- On January 1st, 2020, a five year naming rights sponsorship partnership with ImOn Communications went into effect. Due to the delay in reopening the arena, a one year extension was added to the sponsorship.
- Next year, the city of Cedar Rapids will fund further improvements to the arena including new seating on the NHL side.
- ImOn Ice Arena is open 361 days a year offering a multitude of programing and activities including public skating, skate rentals, hockey for youth and high school, curling, figure skating and other community events.





Shullered Venue Operators Grants



VenuWorks of Cedar Rapids LLC was awarded a Shuttered Venue Operators Grants (SVOG) on behalf of the distressed city of Cedar Rapids owned entertainment venues including the Alliant Energy PowerHouse Arena, the Paramount Theatre and the McGrath Amphitheatre. This grant from the federal government is intended to subsidize losses from the FY21 operating year. These venues were closed by the COVID mandates for several months leading to a financial deficit. VenuWorks has funded that deficit entirely with funds from the SVOG without any financial support from the city of Cedar Rapids. Additionally, grant funding in FY22 and beyond has allowed the venues the ability to stay on schedule in replacing obsolescent furniture and equipment.



Paramount Theatre

The SVOG allowed the Paramount Theatre to make purchases that help ensure efficient operations and increase the patron experience include:

- New & efficient point-of-sale system for concessions
- Counter top wine tap dispenser to provide a faster concession experience
- Expanded access points & repeaters to offer better wifi and cell phone connectivity

McGrath Amphitheatre

With the help of the SVOG, the McGrath Amphitheatre was also able to make purchases and upgrades to equipment that will positively impact customer experience. These purchases include:

- New & efficient point-of-sale system for concessions
- New coolers to create selfserve concessions stations that decrease patron lines
- Installation of permanent wi-fi for artist and management
- Purchase of new first aid equipment and portable AED machine





Alliant Energy PowerHouse

The SVOG allowed the Alliant Energy PowerHouse to make necessary updates to the arena and operations to ensure we are staying current with touring artist and show needs. These updates include:

- Additional security and crowd control equipment including new bike racks
- Additional wheelchairs
- Additional food & beverage equipment to decrease patron lines
- New furniture for artist and touring shows locker rooms
- New chairs for box seats
