With a bachelors in the Musical Arts & Jazz Studies from the University of Michigan, he has lectured on early pop drumming and most extensively on the drumming of Ringo Starr, including for the university's symposium celebrating the 50th anniversary of Sgt. Pepper's Lonely Hearts Club Band, and as a featured artist in the Oxford University Press textbook,

"What Goes On : The Beatles, Their Music and Their Time." As producer, his own shows, "A Night For James: A Tribute to the Music of James Taylor," and Lennon & Mc-Cartney tribute "All Together Now" debuted in 2015 and 2016. More recently in 2019, Billy's research on the drums of Led Zeppelin's John Bonham with Roxy Music drummer Paul Thompson was published in Modern Drummer magazine. His most recent stage credits include "Always... Patsy Cline" and "Smokey Joe's Cafe" (Encore Musical Theatre Company 2021). Billy is so excited and honored to be on stage with this fab cast and production team paying tribute to one of pop music's greatest eras.
