To play, participants use a GeoCaching app on a smartphone or a GPS device to navigate to cleverly hidden containers called geocaches.





Visit GeoCaching.com to set up a free account to get started. You may discover some small items or trinkets inside the geocache - the general rule of thumb is if you take something, leave something of equal or greater value.


