Garland proudly holds the title of Cowboy Hat Capital of Texas, with a legacy of crafting over a million hats each year worn by presidents, celebrities and Western icons. That tradition lives on through local makers like Hatco (Resistol and Stetson), Dorfman Milano (Larry Mahan and Justin) and Master Hatters of Texas, crafting hats here since 1968. This significance earned official state recognition in 2013.

Today, a larger-than-life cowboy hat sculpture in Downtown Garland celebrates that heritage, while the Tiny Hat Hunt brings it to life, guiding visitors through Downtown hotspots in a fun, interactive way. So, saddle up and get ready to explore Downtown Garland!
