CLUES X

- 1. I was remodeled in 2020 when the antiques left.

 Turn me to enter and notice what was here originally.
- 2. We sell iconic Americana styles from the 50s to the 90s. Go around back to see my vintage logo.
- 3. A bank and sewing machines divide this building that was one in the 50s and 60s. Look up. Can you see the line where two became one in 1954?
- 4. Once a Ford dealership and now a little bit spicy, I tell you who built this building and when.
- 5. Coffins were once sold inside, and now there are wings on the side of the building. Look up and you will see a coffin alternative, also used to decorate this building.
- 6. Everyone wants to know what's inside. I am on the Square, sealed in 1991 to be opened in 2041.
- 7. I was in the center of everything, and if you look closely, you can see where I used to pool.
- 8. I tell the story of the original location of the Garland Library, Q now an open space to play.
