Annual Gingerbread House Contest for Adults and Children

- 1. Entry must have components, such as roof & walls made from gingerbread, crackers, or cookies.
- 2. All components, except the base and or special effects, must be edible. For example, all foil or plastic wrapped candies must be unwrapped; lollipops should have stems removed.



- 3. You may add special effects or lighting, (should be battery powered).
- 4. Entry must have been constructed in 2022.
- 5. Before the entries are put on display, a panel of judges will award ribbons and trophies. The people's choice will be awarded on Saturday December the 3rd at 2:00pm. Prizes awarded for Overall Appearance, Use of Materials, Difficulty of Design, Precision, and People's Choice.
- 6. The main structure must be the dominant feature of the entry. The main structure must be a minimum of 7" high by 8" deep.
- 7. Entries must be freestanding and attached to a solid base.
- 8. All entries should be holiday appropriate.
- 9. All entries must be delivered on Thursday, December the 1st, before 7PM. Please bring them to the Rebellion Barn and call the office at 936-564-6631 and someone will meet you. Please make sure you have a name, email, and phone number on the base, as well as, a self-addressed envelope, that matches your entry form.
- 10. Entries must be picked up on December 5, 2022, before 5:00pm, or we will dispose of them.
- 11. Photos of your Gingerbread House may be used on our social media pages as well as any news release we may have.
- 12. Participants must register for the competition by the deadline of November 28, 2022. A registration fee of \$10.00 per entry is due with registration form.

NOTE Any entry that does not meet the guidelines of the contest will remain as a display and will still be eligible for People Choice Award.
