Purpose of the proposal and its anticipated effects, including any changes in existing rules: The purpose is to update							

WSDA's fair rules to be consistent with changes to state statute adopted by the Legislature in 2018. Chapter 280, 2018 Laws updated chapter 15.76 RCW to (1) ensure that if a fair is not held due to a natural disaster, and therefore does not conduct two successful, consecutive annual fairs, it will not lose eligibility to apply for allocations; (2) no longer restricts allocations to reimbursement for premiums and prizes; (3) allow fairs to receive reimbursement for operating expenses incurred; (4) increase the amount of the fair fund spent on allocations; and (5) clarify terms of appointment to the fairs commission. Chapter 16-700 WAC contains the requirements for agricultural fairs receiving allocations from the state fair fund. Proposed amendments reorganize the chapter and clarify qualifications and requirements for all categories of agricultural fairs.

June 7, 2018. Updates to the rules are necessary to comply with updates to the authorizing statute. In addition, this chapter has not been revised since 1997, lacks clarity, and contains outdated information.
