- 1. All dates and deadlines will be announced on the official Schedule of Events and published through Social Media.
- Entrants must be residents of Walker County and not a professional seamstress or home economist.
 Professional home economists or those who earn wages through clothing construction are invited to exhibit their garments but may not be considered in competition.
- 3. All entries must have been constructed within the last calendar year.
- 4. Entry fee is \$5.00 per item or outfit entered.
- 5. Entries are due at Fabric Carousel, the Wednesday before The Fair opens by 5:00 p.m. Entries must be on hangers and protected by a plastic bag. Attach name and address for identification.
- 6. Pattern envelope, guide sheet and fabric samples must be attached to garment at time of entry.
- 7. Judging is not open to the public.
- 8. The Style Show and Awards Ceremony will be immediately following the youth division judging.
- 9. All garments will stay on display at the Fairgrounds through the closing of the Fair. Arrangements are to be made to pick up garments with the clothing committee.
