

Academic Youth Rodeo – Creative Thinking Event Guidelines
Kindergarten Through First Grade
Growing Leadership One Project at a Time

Eligible Participants

- Kindergarten and First Grade students who are residents of Walker County.

Time Limit

- **20 minutes total**
- Time begins once instructions are read and materials are distributed

Materials

- **Paper:** Provided by event staff
- **Coloring tools allowed:**
 - Crayons
 - Colored pencils
 - Markers
- **Full color is allowed and encouraged**

Drawing Rules

- Drawing must relate to the selected theme. The theme will not be provided until the time of the event. Theme may include...
 - 4-H or FFA fair life **and**
 - “*Growing Leadership One Project at a Time*”
- Students must complete their artwork **independently**
- **No words or labels required** (drawing only)

Assistance

- Assistance with reading will be provided by the Academic Rodeo Judges/proctors.
- Parents/Guardians **may not:**
 - Help draw
 - Suggest what to draw
 - Add details to artwork

Completion

- Drawings must be turned in when time is called
- Late entries will not be accepted

Scoring/Judging

- Children are judged on **effort, creativity, and how well the drawing reflects the theme**, not artistic skill.
