General Rules:

- Each Participant must be a resident of Walker County and under age 19.
- All entries must be the work of the participant and may be exhibited by the entrant only.
- The entry fee for each event is \$1.00 (one dollar).
- A first, second, and third place trophy will be awarded in each category in each event. Monetary prizes will be given to the first-place winner of each event. Participation ribbons will be given as additional prizes.
- Exhibits will be watched, and every precaution will be taken to protect all exhibits, but in no case will the Walker County Fair Association be held responsible for damage, theft, or breakage to entries.
- The division chairman retains the right to combine classes in the event of an insufficient number of entries in a class or create a class or classes if deemed necessary.
- Entries are limited to the first 30 participants to sign up per category.
- The Spelling Bee, Math Bee, Craft Project, and displaying of Essays will be Sunday, March 24, 2024, beginning at 9:00 a.m.
- All participants and visitors must enter through the main entrance of the Walker County Fairgrounds.
- If a participant has pre-registered, they must check in at the pre-registration table between 8:00-9:00 a.m., Sunday March 24, 2024.
- Awards will be given during the awards ceremony at the conclusion of all the events of the Academic Rodeo.
