
#### **HOW TO FILL OUT AN EXHIBIT TAG**

You will need to fill one out for each exhibit you enter - pick them up at the Fair Office or fill them out when you turn in your exhibit.

- Tags MUST be written so they are legible.
  - Tags MUST be COMPLETE.
- Each exhibit (non-livestock) must have an Exhibitor Tag attached.
- •Exhibitor Tags are available at the Main Office beginning mid-June and at the Exhibitors Office

beginning August 1st, through Entry Day.

Check-in on exhibit entry day goes much faster when tags are previously and correctly filled out.

#### **ANIMALS:**

All Market Sale Animal Exhibitors must enter ONLINE ONLY. All other livestock entries use the Animal Entry Form or enter online. Animal entry forms can ONLY BE TURNED IN AT THE FAIRGROUNDS.

#### **GENERAL EXHIBITS:**

All other exhibits enter online or use a *GENERAL EXHIBIT FORM*. If an exhibitor has both livestock and general exhibits, both forms will need to be completed. General entry forms can be turned in at the Fairgrounds or at the WSU Extension Office.

#### **PAYMENT OF FEES:**

\*\*We are now accepting payment for Open Livestock fees online. If you don't want to pay online, you can mail payment to PO Box G, Walla Walla, WA 99362, or deliver payment along with a copy of your online entry receipt to the Exhibitors Office on or before August 5. Entries are not complete until the entry fees are received. If we don't receive your payment on or before August 5<sup>th</sup> you will not be considered an exhibitor and not be allowed to exhibit. NO EXCEPTIONS! Please make checks out to Walla Walla Fair & Frontier Days.
