August 5th is the Last Day to register.

Paper Entry forms are also available at the Walla Walla Fairgrounds Main Office.

****Exhibitor's office will be open from July 30th – September 11th, 2026****

Online Entries Open Starting in February!

- Go to WallaWallaFairgrounds.com and click on “The Fair” tab.
- Select “Exhibitors” from the pull-down menu.
- Scroll down and find the “Online Entries” website link.
- Register by clicking on “Exhibitor Registration” in the Navigation Menu

Be sure to fill out entry forms completely.

- **Register with your mailing address (P.O. Box or Street) Please remember to include apartment numbers when registering.**
- **FFA Novice – First Year in that project (regardless of being in Grange, or 4-H)**
- **FFA Advanced – After first year in same project as an FFA member.**
- **4-H Cloverbud 5 to 7 years old, Junior 8 to 10 years old, Intermediate 11 to 13 years old, Senior 14 to 19 years old. Age as of October 1st, 2025**
- **Grange Beginners/Cloverbuds 5 to 7 years old, Junior 8 to 10 years old, Pre-Teens/Intermediate 11 to 13 years old, Teens/Seniors 14 to 19 years old. Age as of January 1st, 2026.**
- You are ready to create entries
- Please be sure to print a copy of the receipt that was sent to your email to keep for your records.

Exhibitor Entry Tag

Entry tags will be printed out by the Exhibitors Office based on the information provided online, or on the paper entry forms.

Check-in tables (tables will be by last name) and they will provide you with your entry tag(s).

Once you have your entry tags proceed to the correct department to turn in your item and tag with the superintendent.

Animals and general exhibits:

All entries are eligible to be registered online and is highly recommended. All Market Sale Animal Exhibitors must enter online only. All other livestock entries can use the Animal Entry Form or enter online. Animal entry forms can only be turned in at the fairgrounds.

All other exhibits enter online or use a *General Exhibit Form*. If an exhibitor has both livestock and general exhibits, both forms will need to be completed. All General entry forms need to be turned in at the Fairgrounds Exhibitors Office.

Payment of fees:

An invoice will be emailed to the email on file when registering. Please make sure the email that is on your registrations is correct. If the invoice is not paid on or before August 12th, 2026, your entries will not be considered fully registered, and you will not be eligible to show.
