SPECIAL EXHIBITORS ENTRY GUIDELINES

Purpose: To support and encourage people who are challenged physically, mentally, or emotionally by age or circumstances, and/or who reside in special facilities such as elder care, group homes, or who participate in programs special to their needs, to enter and share their accomplishments.

- Entries will meet the basic criteria of the department in which they are entered.

- Special Exhibitors may enter exhibits in all departments listing a "SE" designation.
- A statement explaining the Exhibitors experience or current circumstances may accompany the entry.

The articles in this section must be made by the exhibitor, and not exhibited previously at the Walla Walla Fair. Soiled articles or articles in poor condition will not be judged. Pictures must be 18"x10" print with surrounding mat to make entire entry 11"x14" size. Youth entering this department must put age on entry form. Entries limited to 8 items per exhibitor and 1 item per class.
