- Entries may be limited due to available space at superintendent's discretion.
- No For Sale signs may be displayed.
- If exhibitor fails to participate in Herdsmanship, premium money will be withheld.
- Animals must be properly cared for and pens cleaned by 8am each day.
- Any person carrying rabbits inappropriately will have premium money withheld.
- Pens of Three must be owned by the same exhibitor.
- Transport cages must NOT be stored on fairgrounds.
- Rabbits and Cavies will be judged by the American Rabbit Breeders Assn. Standard of Perfection.
- Crossbreds and pocket pets will be judged on appearance, condition and cleanliness.
