

## Camping Lot Rules

- 1. Minors require adult supervision <u>DAY & NIGHT</u>; no minors are to be left in camp area without adequate supervision.
- 2. Purchase of a Camping Spot does not cover gate entry or parking pass. Any person in a camp area is subject to proof of passes.
- 3. Quiet hours will be between 11:00 PM and 7:00 AM.
- 4. Be courteous, be respectful and be kind.
- 5. NO excessively loud radios and/or TVs.
- 6. NO Generators in Lot 5 or Bay Camping no exceptions.
- 7. NO DRIVING BETWEEN TRAILER ROW 1 & 2 in Lot 5.
- 8. NO animals (exception: service animals), <u>mopeds, motor vehicles,</u> etc. allowed.
- 9. NO alcoholic beverages allowed in parking or camping areas.
- 10. NO marijuana use allowed on grounds. Follow State Laws and Regulations.
- 11. ALL CAMPERS MUST FOLLOW LISTED HAUL IN AND HAUL OUT TIMES. NO EARLY HAUL IN OR OUT FROM ANY LOT!
- 12. Campers must be removed from grounds no later than Noon the day following Fair (Labor Day each year.)
- 13. No tents/pop-ups outside of assigned space, no exceptions.
- 14. Follow State Laws and Regulations pertaining to firearms.

Failure to abide by the above listed rules may result in removal from the Fairgrounds camping area. Camper will be responsible for all costs incurred with removal.
