- Soiled articles will not be judged.
- Articles must not be made prior to last year's fair.
- There is no limit on the number of articles entered as long as no two articles are from the same pattern.
- All fabric items must have a permanently attached care label or a 3x5 card with care instructions
- All items in this department must be labeled with a swatch of fabric that is slip stitched in with exhibitor name and year in project [not judged on stitching].
- All items must be accompanied by a 3x5 card explaining the technique used, why you choose the fabric/pattern, what you did to upcycle the material or item and any other information that best describes the item you have entered. Please make card legible as the judge will be reading the cards.

Division

A - Clothing & Personal Accessories

B - Household and Home or Room Décor- Sewn

C - Single Separates (Skirts, Shorts, Slacks, Blouse, Shirt, Jumper)

D - Coordinated Separates (2 or more garments such as Skirt & Blouse, Pant & Shirt)

E - Pajamas or Sleepwear

F - Daytime Dress

G - Eveningwear (Clothing for formal or semi-formal occasions)

H - Coat or Suit (Suits of matching or coordinating fabrics)

I - Miscellaneous: Costumes, any item that does not fit into above classes.
