**C - Single Separates** (Skirts, Shorts, Slacks, Blouse, Shirt, Jumper)

**D - Coordinated Separates** (2 or more garments such as Skirt & Blouse, Pant & Shirt)

**E - Pajamas or Sleepwear**

**F - Daytime Dress**

**G - Eveningwear** (Clothing for formal or semi-formal occasions)

**H - Coat or Suit** (Suits of matching or coordinating fabrics)

**I - Miscellaneous: Costumes, any item that does not fit into above classes.**
