- Include technique, i.e. batik, copper tooling, etc.
- Please specify on **exhibit tag** whether item is:
  - (M) made from a kit
  - (O) original design
  - (P) patterns/instruction
- Items entered should exhibit knowledge of the principles of design and color, good craftsmanship and skillful use of materials and tools.
- Crafts made of building blocks must be glued together and secured to the platform if applicable.
- Similar exhibits must show different skills.
- Three entries per class maximum
- Exhibits larger than 22” by 22” **must** have Superintendent approval prior to exhibit turn in day.

### L – Handmade Project Equipment

- This division is designed to allow 4-H, Grange & FFA members to enter handmade, by the member, items that are suitable for being used with another of their project areas.
- Suggested items are; animal blankets, feed pans, tack boxes, lead ropes, tail bags, show sticks, performing arts costumes or props, etc.
- No two articles from the same exhibitor may be alike or made from the same pattern.
- **Additional information on the accompanying 3” by 5” should include what project it is used with, what was learned while making the item, and how it is cleaned or maintained.**
