

Department 33 Open Rabbits

- Each rabbit must be identified by a legible, permanent tattoo in the left ear. Un-tattooed animals will not be accepted.
- Does with a litter, heavily pregnant does or animals under 8 weeks will not be accepted.
- Exhibitors who fail to participate in Herdsmanship will have premium money withheld.
- **Entries may be limited due to available space at superintendent's discretion.**
- No For Sale signs may be displayed.
- Animals must be properly cared for and pens cleaned by 8am each day.
- Any person carrying rabbits inappropriately will have premium money withheld.
- Pens of Three must be owned by the same exhibitor.
- Transport cages must **not** be stored on fairgrounds.
- Rabbits will be judged by the American Rabbit Breeders Assn. Standard of Perfection.
- Crossbreds will be judged on appearance, condition and cleanliness.
- **Educational exhibits for this department are entered under Department 25, Educational Exhibits**
- All Leased Animals must have a lease agreement turned into the Exhibitors Office by August 5th.

1. Senior buck, less than 6 months for Small Breed, less than 8 months for Large Breed
2. Senior doe, less than 6 months for Small Breed, less than 8 months for Large Breed
3. Intermediate buck, 6 to 8 months old (Large Breeds Only)
4. Intermediate doe, 6 to 8 months old (Large Breeds Only)
5. Junior buck, 3 to 6 months old
6. Junior doe, 3 to 6 months old
7. Pre-junior buck, under 3 months old (only for limited large breeds)
8. Pre-junior doe, under 3 months old (only for limited large breeds)

B – Meat Classes

Birth date required on entry form for meat classes.

CLASS

1. Fryer, 3 to 5 pounds, not over 10 weeks of age.
2. Pen of 3, 3 to 5 pounds, not over 10 weeks of age
3. Roasters, over 5 pounds and under 6 months of age
4. Stewers, over 5 pounds and over 6 months of age
