- Open to youth ages 5 to 17
- Garment may be made by the youth, parent, or grandparent.
- Garments must be entered and judged as an exhibit in the proper class in the open division.
- Youth may model one outfit or article for the judges.
- Any outfit is one entry
- **In order to receive points or ribbons, participants must model both for the judges and for the public fashion revue.** The judging contest is Monday, August 24, from 9:00 am to 2:00 pm in the Community Center at the fairgrounds. The public Fashion Revue is Saturday, August 29, at 7:00 pm in the Community Center at the fairgrounds.
