- All breeding animals must be owned by exhibitor for at least 60 days prior to the opening day of the fair.
- Animals shown in group classes must first have been entered and shown in individual classes. Best Pair, Young Flock, and Get of Sire must be bred and owned by exhibitor. Market sheep must be shorn prior to the fair. They cannot be shown with more than ½ inch of wool.
- Blanket must be removed by 8:00 am. All exhibitors are expected to groom and care for their animal(s) when at the Fair.
- Do not enter Championship classes [ribbon only, no premium].
- All Leased Breeding Animals (excluding sale animals) must have a lease agreement turned into the Exhibitors Office by August 5th.

1. Ram, 1 year old and under 2 years
2. Ram Lamb, under one year
3. Pair of Ram Lambs
4. Ewe, one-year-old and under two

7. Pair of Yearling Ewes – bred by exhibitor
8. Spring Ewe Lamb
9. Fall Ewe Lamb
10. Pair of Ewe Lambs – bred by exhibitor
11. Young Flock, 1 Ram Lamb & 2 Ewe Lambs
12. Get-of-Sire, four sheep, either sex, yearlings, or lambs, sired by the same Ram, all bred, and owned by exhibitor
13. Best Pair, two Ewes, two Rams or one Ewe and one Ram
14. Flock, 1 Ram any age, Yearling Ewes & 2 Ewe Lambs
15. Young Flock consists of Ram lamb and two Ewe lambs
