Special Exhibitors Entry Guidelines

Purpose: To support and encourage people who are challenged physically, mentally, or emotionally by age or circumstances, and/or who reside in special facilities such as elder care, group homes, or who participate in programs special to their needs, to enter and share their accomplishments with the community-at-large.

- Entries will meet the basic criteria of the department in which they are entered.
- Entries will be judged in their respective Division/Class and will be displayed in the Special Exhibitors section to allow access during the fair.
- Special Exhibitors (SE) may enter exhibits in all departments listing a “SE” designation.
- A statement explaining the Exhibitors experience or current circumstances may accompany the entry and is greatly encouraged.

The articles in this section must be made by the exhibitor and not exhibited previously at the Walla Walla Fair. All articles within this department must put age on entry form. Entries are limited to 12 items per exhibitor and 2 items per class.

Media accepted: 2D (paintings); water-based oils, oils, acrylics, collage, mixed media, watercolor, charcoal, pencil, pen and ink, pastel, oil pastel, chalk, crayon, gouache, encaustic, scratch board and 3D: sculptures, mobiles, paper mache.

Framing: all entries must be framed in a boarder frame. All paintings & drawings done in charcoal, pastel, oil pastel, chalk, pencils, scratch board, watercolor, pen & ink, must be framed under Plexiglass or glass. Must be equipped with 2 screw eyes or two wire mount brackets with screws and woven picture wire.
