- Roll fleeces flesh side out, tied or untied. If untied, place it in a clear plastic bag. Angora fleeces should be packaged appropriately. Classes may be combined depending on the number of fleeces entered in each class.
- **Entry Fee:** There is a \$5.00 per wool entry fee, which must be received on or before August 5th to receive prizes.

A – Wool Show, Fleeces

- **Examples of Wool Grades**
 - Fine & Half: Debouillet, Rambouillet, Merino, Panama, Targhee, some Columbia, Corriedale.
 - Three eighths: Columbia, Corriedale, Shropshire and Romeldale
 - Quarter: Most of the down (meat) breeds
 - Low Quarter: Romney, Border Leicester, some Lincoln & Coopworth
 - Common & Braid: Cotswold and Lincoln
