- All female cattle over 4 months old require brucellosis vaccination and a legible tattoo
- All females over 20 months old require a negative brucellosis test.
- All cattle over 12 months old require a negative tuberculosis test within 60 days. When Crossing state lines.
- All Leased Animals must have a lease agreement turned into the Exhibitors Office by August 5th.
