RULES GOVERNING CLOTHING EXHIBITS

1. Champion & Reserve Champion Awards will be given per judges' decision per department, division, or class.
2. Age classification is based on your age as of January 1 of the current year.
3. "Garment" is a single piece of clothing.
4. "Outfit" is more than one piece of clothing.
5. All entries must be sewn by the exhibitor.
6. Clothing exhibits may have been worn but must be clean and pressed for judging.
7. Each entry must have exhibitor's name, and a club securely fastened on the inside of the garment; this is not the entry tag.

PREMIUMS: 1st - \$2.25 2nd - \$2.00 3rd - \$1.75 4th - \$1.50

Division Letter:

A. Clothing – Age 8-10

Class #:

1. Simple blouse, shirt, or vest
2. Skirt
3. Poncho, cape, or simple jacket
4. Lounge, sleepwear, or robe
5. Pants or shorts
6. Dress or jumper
7. Clothing item in conjunction with Fair theme
8. Apron or sewn accessory.

Division Letter:

B. Clothing – Age 11-13

Class #:

1. Garment for casual wear or sports
2. Garment for any other person other than exhibitor
3. Garment for best wear or party
4. Complete costume for any event, include photo of exhibitor in the garment.
5. Garment for lounge or sleep
6. Garment in conjunction with Fair theme
7. Garment for Pet, must include a photo of pet in garment

Division Letter:

C. Clothing – Age 14 & up

Class #:

1. Outfit for any other person other than the exhibitor
2. Outfit for casual, school, or sports
3. Garment or outfit from recycled materials.
4. Outfit for best wear or party
5. Complete outfit for any event, including photo of exhibitor wearing costume.
6. Tailored garment (for example, trousers, coat, highly fitted garment)
7. Garment or outfit in conjunction with Fair theme
8. Garment for a pet, must include photo of pet wearing garment
9. Outfit for lounge, sleepwear or robe
10. Any other item not listed above

PREMIUMS: 1st - \$1.75 2nd - \$1.50 3rd - \$1.25 4th - \$1.00

Division Letter:

D. Equestrian Attire

RULE: Article must be sewn.

Class #:

1. Saddle pad or stable blanket
2. Riding apparel
3. Horse accessory
4. Riding accessory

RULES GOVERNING LOOKING GOOD EXHIBITS

1. Champion & Reserve Champion Awards will be given per judges' decision per department, division, or class.
2. Age classification on your age as of January 1 of the current year.
3. Class # 6 entry will be left at the fair after judging. It will be on Display
4. Class #6 entry does NOT need to be worn for the judging.

E. Looking Good, Age 8-10

F. Looking Good, Age 11-13

G. Looking Good, Age 14 & up

Class #:

1. Photo scrapbook of exhibitor wearing a mix and match clothing combination demonstrating wardrobe versatility.
2. Clothing first aid kit.
3. Creative craft on a ready-to-wear article, (i.e., tie dye, appliqué, paint, etc.).
4. Clothing article which has been recycled (article should be accompanied with before picture).
5. Create/decorate embellished items, bows, shoes, hat and accessories.
6. Total outfit with accessories purchased from a thrift shop, must have receipts & photo of outfit being worn. This outfit should NOT be worn for judging. Entire outfit will be left at the Fair after judging for display.
7. Any other Looking Good exhibit not listed above.
