Rules Governing Cloverbud Exhibits:

1. Age classification is based on your age as of January 1 of the current year.
2. Open to youth Age 5 - 8 enrolled in the 4-H Cloverbud project or members of other youth groups doing equivalent work.
3. All participants will receive a participation ribbon for each of their entries, but premium money will not be awarded.
4. Members may make four (4) entries; only one per class number.
5. Only small animals (cats, dogs, covies, rabbits, etc.) may be brought to be judged. Animals must be taken home after judging. You are encouraged to bring a 5x7 photo of your entry.
6. Food items will be judged but not kept at the Fair for display. You are encouraged to bring a 5x7 photo of your entry.
7. All other entries will be displayed after judging. They are to be picked up between 3:00 PM – 6:00 PM on the Tuesday after the Fair.

This is a non-competitive opportunity for Cloverbud Members to receive an introduction to the judging process and receive recognition for their project work.

A. Cloverbuds

Class #:

1. Any food item, mixes allowed
2. Article made for the home
3. 14" x 22" Poster about the care of an animal
4. One fruit or vegetable that you grew
5. Drawing or painting using any media
6. Item made from a kit
7. Picture made using fingerpaint
8. Picture made with seeds
9. Item made from wood. No power tools may be used. Can be made from a kit.
10. Any small pet; must be brought in a crate

RULES GOVERNING EXPLORING EXHIBITS

1. Age classification is based on your age as of January 1 of the current year
2. Must be 8 -11 years old, AND first year of exhibiting, unless exempt by Superintendent
3. Champion & Reserve Champion Awards will be given per judges' decision per department, division, or class
4. Non-perishable entries must remain on display following judging and removed between 3 and 6 pm on Tuesday immediately following the fair. Entries not removed may be discarded. Entries removed early will not receive premium money.
5. Animals exhibited in the Exploring project cannot be exhibited in any other Junior Fair department. Animals entered in this project will not be displayed and must be taken home after judging.
6. All perishable items can be removed and replaced with a photo for display during the Fair.

B. Exploring

Class #:

1. Decorated food, 3 similar items; cookies, cupcakes; may use frosting and candy
2. One serving of a HEALTHY snack on a plate
3. Brownies, 3 on a plate, from scratch, no mix and no nutmeats
4. Create a holiday seasonal item (any holiday greeting card, wrapping paper or decoration)
5. A simple garment or article sewn without using a serger (No zipper, set-in sleeves, collar or buttonholes)
6. A simple garment or article, Knitted
7. A simple garment or article, Crocheted
8. A simple art or craft (No Kits); example, tie dye item, stamping art, jewelry
9. A simple art or craft made from a kit; example, diamond art, string art
10. A simple art or craft made from leather (kit may be used)
11. Drawing or painting using ANY media
12. A houseplant started from a CUTTING or seed (April 15 or before)
13. Three photos, 4x6, on 8.5 x 11 inch card stock
14. Homemade first aid kit, including emergency phone numbers (no bigger than a shoe box)
15. A craft made from materials found in nature
16. Woodworking item, NO POWER TOOLS, may use a kit
17. A plate of fruit or vegetables from your garden; maximum 3 items
18. 14" x 22" poster depicting your family tree
19. 14" x 22" poster of your favorite hobby
20. Any usable item made from recycled materials
21. Pet on a leash or crated. Must not be exhibited at Fair in any other class. Please bring a 5x7 photo to be left after judging for display during the Fair.
