RULES GOVERNING FLOWERS HOUSE PLANTS & HOME GROUND EXHIBITS

1. Champion & Reserve Champion Awards will be given per judges' discretion per department, division, or class.
2. Age classification is based on you age as of January 1 of the current year.
3. Exhibitors are limited to seven (7) entries in EACH division.
4. Names of flowers and plants must be written on the entry tag for all starred * items.
5. Entries in Flowers classes 1 & 2 may not be a flower for which there is an individual class.
6. All cut flowers must be in a clean and clear, non-tinted, container. Except for Class number 14.
7. Gladiolus, sunflowers and tall grasses must be in bottom heavy containers.
8. Plants, pots, and flowers must be clean & free from insects & disease. Unhealthy plants will be disqualified & removed.
9. If there is a class for a specific plant type, it must be entered in that class.
10. No Exhibit can be larger than 20" W x 20" L x 10" H (container) Plants are measured from the soil or water to top of plant.

Class #:

1. Five (5) stems of a variety of unlisted Annuals*
2. Five (5) stems of a variety of unlisted Perennials
3. Bouquet of at least five (5) different Annuals*, at least 2 stems of each variety
4. Bouquet of at least five (5) different Perennials*, at least 2 stems of each variety
5. Bouquet of at least five (5) different Home-Grown Wild Flowers*, at least 2 stems of each variety
6. Five (5) stems of Marigolds
7. Five (5) stems of Snapdragons
8. Five (5) stems of Petunias
9. Five (5) stems of Zinnias
10. Gladiolus, single spike, in bloom
11. Five (5) different stems of Herbs, different variety
12. Three (3) stems of Sunflowers
13. 5 Stems same variety of ornamental grass not to exceed 18" high*
14. Arrangement of annuals or perennials*
15. Miniature Arrangement*

Class #:

1. Collection of three (3) different foliage or flowering plants in same container*
2. Collection of three different foliage or flowering plants in the same container from a previous year*
3. Foliage or flowering plant started this year. List the date started*
4. Hanging plant – foliage or vine, *must be able to be hung.
5. Herb Garden – at least 3 different herbs*
6. Ivy Plant*
7. African Violet (in bloom)
8. Jade Plant
9. Single Cactus*
10. Specialty Plants (Christmas Cactus, Bonsai Tree Onion Plant, etc.*)
11. Succulent Dish Garden*, at least 3 different varieties of plants
12. Cactus Dish Garden*, at least 3 different varieties of plants
13. Terrarium (with cover) * at least 3 different varieties of plants
14. Window Box (not larger than 24" x 8") *
15. Fairy Garden (**no larger than 20" x 20" x 10" at least 5 varieties of plants**)*

1. Potpourri (list all ingredients on a card)
2. Dried flower arrangement for table

7. Holiday arrangement – can include dried or fresh plant material
8. Any other creative plant craft
9. Any arrangement using more than one type of material (dried, fresh, silk and etc)
