RULES GOVERNING HORSE & PONY EXHIBITS

1. No exhibitor may exhibit more than two (2) animals in the project. Team driving is exempt from this limit.
2. No exhibitor will be allowed more than one entry under each class.
3. An exhibitor may enter as many classes for which they are eligible.
4. Age Classification: Age is based on your age as of January 1, of the current year
5. No intact male horses may be shown
6. All animals participating in the WCF Junior Horse & Pony Show will be confined to the Horse Arena end of the fairgrounds.
7. In addition to the Health Regulations in the WCF Premium Book, a printed copy of a current negative Coggins test must be turned in: a) to the activity leader the first time an animal is on the WCF property for a training event b) to the Junior Superintendent at any WCF show or event (I.e., fun show, Jr. horse show)
8. Exhibitors are required to display their exhibitor number when in the show ring
9. To be eligible to show at the Walworth County Junior Horse & Pony Show, participants must:
 - Be eligible per the youth organization rules to which they show under
 - Participate in one clinic at the WCF per participant and animal unit
 - Completed 60 minutes minimum of documented education pertaining to the health & care of equines
10. The WCF Junior Horse & Pony Show is an opportunity for the youth to exhibit the skills learned during the current project year. To promote this:
 - Equines may not be driven, ridden or schooled by anyone other than the Exhibitor
 - Special permission for lunging another exhibitor's equine may be obtained prior to the Junior Horse & Pony Show from the Junior Superintendent.
11. TWO MINUTE GATE CALL: For each class, the gate will be closed two minutes after each class has been called to enter the arena unless a tack change has been requested. The tack change request must be submitted to the gate person or announcer a minimum of TWO CLASSES in advance.
12. Exhibitors must wear SEI approved protective headgear and proper footwear, according to discipline, at ALL times while mounted or driving. Driving passengers, regardless of age, are required to wear SEI approved protective headgear as well.
13. Miniature Horses are defined as 38" or under. Ponies are defined as over 38" to 56". Horses are defined as over 56". Once an equine enters a size division, the equine must remain in that size division for the entire show. An exhibitor may choose to enter the equine in a larger size division if they desire. Equines may never go down in size. Equines may be measured.
14. Enter all exhibits under correct class numbers, wrong entries will be disqualified.
15. The Top 2 place finishers, no matter what place, are eligible for Grand and Reserve
