1. Grand & Reserve Champion Awards will be given at the judges' discretion per department, division, or class.
2. Age classification is based on your age as of January 1 of the current year.

Division Letter:

A. Youth Leadership, Age 8-10

Class #:

1. Written summary of someone whom you think is a good leader.
2. Notebook, poster, or display of ideas for meeting activities.
3. Photo Story (3-5 pictures mounted on 14" x 22" poster board, with captions) of a leadership experience you had.
4. Promotional poster 14" x 22"
5. Any other display, poster, or exhibit appropriate for youth leadership

Division Letter:

B. Youth Leadership, Age 11-13

Class #:

1. Notebook, poster or display on a youth service project that you were involved in.
2. Notebook, poster or display of completed leadership activities you have planned.
3. Any other display, poster, or exhibit appropriate for age level.
4. Create an 8-1/2 x 11" flyer that offers to share a skill you have learned with others.

Division Letter:

C. Youth Leadership, Age 14 & up

Class #:

1. Treasure chest of your strengths and weaknesses.
2. Notebook, scrapbook, poster, or display of completed leadership or community service projects that you have helped plan and conduct.
3. Create a reproducible flyer, brochure, or 8 1/2" X 11" poster promoting your youth organization.
4. Any other display, poster, or exhibit appropriate for age level.

Division Letter:

D. Service Learning, All Ages

Class #:

1. Poster, display or notebook that reflects what you accomplished in the four steps of service learning (preparation, action, reflection, and assessment).

RULES GOVERNING SELF DETERMINED EXHIBITS

1. Grand & Reserve Champion Awards will be given at the judges' discretion per department, division, or class
2. Age classification is based on your age as of January 1 of the current year.
3. Exhibit a product of your year-long independent study. Acceptable products include, but are not limited to displays, posters, activity plans, models, etc.
4. Videos and slides are acceptable, but no audio-visual equipment will be provided for judging; you will need to bring your own.
5. A statement of purpose, equipment used, procedure followed, results observed, conclusions drawn and references consulted should accompany the exhibited item.
