RULES GOVERNING ANTIQUE EXHIBITS

1. Entries close online at 11:59 PM the First Friday in August.
2. Exhibitor must have season pass.
3. All exhibits to be in place by 6:00 PM on Tuesday of Fair Week. The Superintendent will receive entries on Monday, 10:00 AM - 6:00 PM and on Tuesday, 12:00 Noon - 6:00 PM.
4. Check out is Tuesday after the Fair, from 9:00 AM to 6:00 PM. To expedite the return of your items, please write the entry number and a brief description on each corresponding Claim Check. Alphabetize by division letter for ease of check out.
5. No professionals may exhibit in this Department. A "professional" is described as one who earns their primary income in this Department.
6. Each exhibitor will be permitted to submit only one entry in any one class. Please read each entry description carefully. Items entered under the wrong entry number may be disqualified.
7. All exhibits SHALL BE clean, odor free, free of all mold, dust and mildew, and SHALL BE in presentable condition.
8. **Exhibitors are limited to 30 entries.**
9. The Superintendent shall have the right to refuse any item that is presented as unsafe (cracked, against rules).
10. No items by any exhibitor previously receiving an award/ribbon at this Fair will be accepted for competition until a period of three (3) years has passed.
11. Exhibitors must bring their own entries to the fair prepared with entry tag prior to arrival.
12. Antiques should be 70 years or more old, unless otherwise specified.
13. Judges are state certified and have been carefully selected. All exhibitors submitting exhibits at the Fair accept these judges and agree to abide by their decisions. The decision of the judge will be final in all classes. Any exhibitor who attempts to interfere with the judge in any manner will forfeit all premiums awarded. Additionally, the exhibitor will be asked to leave the building.
14. Champion and Best of Show Awards are given per judges' discretion per department, division or class.
15. Superintendents in charge and their assistants will take every precaution for the safe keeping of all items on exhibit after their arrival, by the Walworth County Agricultural Society, Inc. their employees and volunteers will not be responsible for loss or damage that may occur. **Security guard on duty all night in the building.**

PLEASE NOTE: *The miscellaneous categories are very competitive. Your entry will be disqualified if it is eligible for any specific category.*
