RULES GOVERNING CULTURAL ARTS BUILDING EXHIBITS

1. Entries close online at 11:59 PM the first Friday in August.
2. Exhibitors must have a season pass.
3. Entries may be brought in on Monday, preceding opening day of fair from noon – 7:00 PM. Also on Tuesday, 9:00 AM – 12 Noon. **No Entries will be accepted outside these hours.**
4. Champion & Best of Show Awards will be given per judges' discretion per department, division, or class.
5. Exhibits will be released from the Cultural Arts Building between 2:00 PM and 6:00 PM on Tuesday after Fair.
6. No prizes will be awarded to articles not mentioned in premium list. All articles entered **MUST** be work of exhibitor.
7. **An article previously exhibited under a class number at this Fair may not be exhibited under that class number at the Walworth County Fair again.**
8. Work must have been completed within the last two years.
9. No professionals may exhibit in this department, professionals shall be described as anyone that earns primary income in that department, unless entering under the professional photography division.
10. **No more than (1) one entry per exhibitor under each class number.**
11. Spectators are requested to refrain from making comments during the judging or they will be asked to leave.
12. If your exhibit requires hanging, exhibit with proper hanging method.
13. Any work entered with the wrong tag will be disqualified.

RULES GOVERNING ART & CRAFT EXHIBITS – PLEASE READ THEM CAREFULLY

1. Read all instructions under Cultural Arts Building.
2. **Categories A – F, limit 20 entries per person.**
3. All exhibits entered for single premiums shall not be included in collections.
4. All entries in arts and crafts must be originals. No kits unless otherwise specified
5. All paintings and drawings must be framed. Gallery wrap is acceptable framing.
 - a. Portraits: A pictorial representation of a person or persons showing his, her, or their faces. No animals as main subject matter.
 - b. Paintings can be any size, unless otherwise noted.
 - c. Mixed Media entries must show the use of more than one media (example oil & pastel) Media used is to be listed on the entry tag.
6. All art entry titles – the subject must be the major object of the exhibit.
7. Name of exhibitor must not appear on exhibit. Put entry tag on upper right-hand corner of exhibit. Tape or tie to backside and hang the tag over to the front.
8. **All framed pictures must be prepared for hanging with wire only;** metal fasteners are unacceptable. The Fair is not responsible for any damage due to improper display techniques; items may be disqualified.
 - a. Matted pictures must have a permanent wire mount or a hole in the center of the mat for hanging on a peg board hook. The use of masking tape or duct tape is unacceptable.
 - b. Canvases need not be framed but must have a permanent wire mount for hanging on a pegboard hook. The use of masking tape or duct tape is unacceptable.
9. Any work not in harmony or good taste with the family-oriented Walworth County Fair will be disqualified.

2. Exhibitors must have a season pass.
3. Entries may be brought in on Friday 8:00 AM – 8:00 PM and Saturday 9:00 AM - 1:00 PM, preceding opening day of Fair. **NO ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED OUTSIDE THESE HOURS.**
4. Champion and Best of Show Awards are per judges' discretion per department, division, or class.
5. Exhibits are to be released from the Cultural Arts building between 2:00 PM and 6:00 PM the Tuesday after the Fair.
6. No prizes will be awarded to articles not mentioned in Premium List. All articles entered **MUST** be the work of the exhibitor.
7. **An article previously exhibited under a class number, at THIS FAIR may not be exhibited at this FAIR again.**
8. Work must have been completed within the last two years.
9. **NO MORE THAN ONE (1) ENTRY PER EXHIBITOR UNDER EACH CLASS NUMBER OR BOTH PROJECTS WILL BE DISQUALIFIED.**
10. Spectators are requested to refrain from making comments during the judging, or they will be asked to leave.

RULES GOVERNING PHOTOGRAPHY EXHIBITS ONLY- READ THEM CAREFULLY

1. Name of exhibitor must **NOT** appear on exhibit.
2. Entry tags are to be hung in the upper right-hand corner of the mat. Tape string to back of exhibit.
3. Photographs must have been taken within the last two years.
4. **NO BORDERS OR PRINTED MAT ON PHOTOS.**
5. All photographs must be mounted on top of a stiff **BLACK MAT BOARD** (NO tag board, NO cut opening, and NO foam core.)
6. **ALL MOUNTED BOARDS MUST BE 11" X 14"**
7. **PHOTOS MUST BE ATTACHED WITH RUBBER CEMENT.** If photos fall before judging they will be disqualified.
8. Must have a hole punched in center of mat board for hanging photograph on a hook for display
9. Judging is done on the basis of pictorial quality and adherence to the theme.
10. Each exhibitor is limited to a maximum of 60 entries.
11. **NO DIGITAL MANIPULATION WITH COMPUTER PROGRAMS (LIGHTROOM, PHOTO SHOP, ECT)**
Except as noted. Any photo found to be manipulated by the judges will be disqualified.

13. Once you have won TOP PHOTOGRAPHER, you must advance and can not re-enter under a lower division

Once all the Champions are judged for a division, all the Champions for the 11 categories will be judged for a Grand Champion of that division. Once all the divisions have been judged and the Grand Champions awarded, the four (4) Grand Champions will be judged against each other for TOP PHOTOGRAPHER.

RULES GOVERNING YOUTH PHOTOGRAPHY EXHIBITS:

1. All photos must be mounted on black board not to exceed 7" x 9" and must be standard size print 1- 5" x 7".
2. No enlargements, Polaroids, or Panoramic - No Black & White photos.
3. No more than one entry per exhibitor per class.
