## **RULES GOVERNING GOAT EXHIBITS**

1. Entries close online at 11:59 PM the First Friday in August.
2. Exhibitor must have season pass.
3. Official ADGA Show.
4. Non-Lactating animals to be in place Tuesday by 8:00 PM, before the Fair, Lactating animals to be in place Thursday by 8:00 PM. **Registration check-in: Friday, 4:00-7:00 PM.**
5. All animals being shown must be registered in the name of the exhibitor. All animals must be registered with A.D.G.A. All animals MUST be entered under the name of the owner shown on the registration papers. No signed transfers will be accepted. Registration papers must be available to the Superintendent. All Doe Show. Horns NOT allowed. The original registration certificate is required for all animals. The original or stamped duplicate by ADGA is required for all animals under 6 months of age. NO COPIES ACCEPTED.
6. No straw furnished by the fair. No clipping in barns.
7. ADGA rules will govern. The Junior & Senior show are separately sanctioned.
8. All animals shown in group classes must have shown in their regular single class.
9. Not more than two prizes shall be awarded to an exhibitor under one class number and only one prize in the group or herd classes may be awarded to one exhibitor.
10. No livestock will be allowed to leave the fairgrounds until 4:00 pm. Monday, Labor Day.
11. Exhibitors showing permanent champions, as a courtesy to others, should show in the champion challenge class.
12. Please indicate the # of pens on your entry blank.
13. Show order is subject to change.
14. Only Goats entered will be allowed on the grounds.

## **AGE CLASSIFICATIONS:**

1. Junior Kid – Born on or after April 1, but before or on Sept. 1
2. Intermediate Kid – Born March 1<sup>st</sup> – March 31<sup>st</sup>
3. Senior Kid – Born on or after Feb. 1, but before or on Feb. 29
4. Junior Yearling – Born on or after Sept. 1 of previous year but before or on Jan. 31
5. Senior Yearling Dry – Born on or after Sept. 1 of 2 years past and before or on Aug. 31 of previous year
6. Ages of Senior Division as of Sept. 1
7. Jr. Get of Sire – to consist of 3 animals from the Jr. Division having the same sire
8. Sr. Get of Sire – to consist of 3 animals having the same sire, with at least two being in milk
9. Produce of Dam – to consist of 2 does, the product of the same dam
10. Best 3 Goats – to consist of 3 does any age, owned by the same exhibitor
