Ranch Pleasure entries may not cross enter into English/Western Pleasure classes. No crossovers between age brackets. 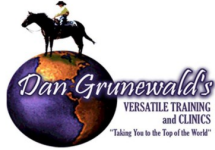

High Point Rules and Information

Division High Point:

- 1) Division high point is offered in five divisions: Youth (13 & under), Jr. (14-17), Sr. (18-39), Select (40 & over), and Ranch (all ages).
- 2) Awards will be presented for grand and reserve high point in each of the five divisions.
- 3) Points are based on horse/rider combination.
- 4) Each horse/rider combination may nominate themselves for no more than one high point division.
- 5) No crossovers between age brackets.
- 6) Division high point fee is \$5 per horse/rider combination.
- 7) Each horse/rider combination must sign-up for division high point before showmanship classes begin.
- 8) Only certain classes count for division high point (see table for details).
- 9) In case of a tie for division high point, the higher placing exhibitor in showmanship wins.

Team Challenge High Point:

- 1) Each team must consist of two exhibitors from the same division (ex: 2 exhibitors from Youth, or 2 exhibitors from Ranch).
- 2) Awards will be presented for grand and reserve overall teams.
- 3) Team challenge fee is \$20 per team.
- 4) Points are based on horse/rider combination.
- 5) A horse/rider combination may not compete on more than one team.
- 6) No crossovers between age brackets.
- 7) Teams must sign up for Team Challenge before showmanship classes begin.
- 8) Only certain classes count for Team Challenge (see table below).
- 9) In case of a tie for Team Challenge, the higher placing(s) in showmanship wins.
