2023 Grain Truck Race Rules

Stock Class

- 1. Each participant must be at least 18 years of age. No passengers will be allowed.
- 2. Drivers must wear a helmet, eye protection and a seat belt during the race.
- 3. Drivers must remain inside their vehicle until they are notified by an official that it's safe to exit the vehicle.
- 4. No hot rodding in the pit area.
- 5. Doors must be shut securely at all times during the race. Any open door during the race will be cause for disqualification.
- 6. There is no alcohol or drugs allowed in the pit area. Any driver or pit crew caught with alcohol or drugs will be disqualified.
- 7. Front seats must be securely bolted to the floor with secure functioning seat belt.
- 8. Vehicles are required to have a working fire extinguisher inside the vehicle during the race.
- 9. Vehicles must have full front bumpers.
- 10. One functional fuel tank per vehicle. Mounted safe, secure, not leaking. All others must be removed, or have visible drain plugs removed, or have visible holes drilled through them.
- 11. Trucks must have the stock engine, driveline, suspension, & tire size. Any carburetor is allowed.
- 12. Must have working brakes.
- 13. 2-ton trucks or larger, both single axle and tandem trucks
- 14. All batteries must be secured under the hood. If battery is relocated inside the cab, it must be secured to the floor and covered to protect the driver
- 15. Needs to have a complete wood or steel box
- 16. Split rims allowed with valve core removed from outer duals.
- 17. Glass does not need to be removed
- 18. Truck numbers need to be legible & displayed on both truck doors
- 19. Helmet, Long sleeves, pants, gloves required to compete
- 20. Officials decision is final

Open Class

- 1. Each participant must be at least 18 years of age. No passengers will be allowed.
- 2. Drivers must wear a helmet, eye protection, and fire suit during the race.
- 3. Drivers must remain inside their vehicle until they are notified by an official that it's safe to exit the vehicle.
- 4. No hot rodding in the pit area.
- 5. Doors must be shut securely at all times during the race. Any open door during the race will be cause for disqualification.
- 6. Trucks must have a roll bar behind the cab with 2 kickers. 4 point minimum attached to the frame.
- 7. There is no alcohol or drugs allowed in the pit area. Any driver or pit crew caught with alcohol or drugs will be disqualified.
- 9. Trucks must have a racing seat and be securely bolted to the floor with a minimum of 4 point harness.
- 10. Vehicles are required to have a working fire extinguisher inside the vehicle during the race.
- 11. Vehicles must have full front bumpers.
- 12. One functional fuel tank per vehicle. Mounted safe, secure, not leaking. All others must be removed, or have visible drain plugs removed, or have visible holes drilled through them.
- 13. Trucks must have the stock engine, driveline, suspension, & tire size. Any carburetor is allowed.
- 14. Must have working brakes.
- 15. 2-ton trucks or larger, both single axle and tandem trucks. Trucks must still look like a grain truck.
- 16. All batteries must be secured under the hood. If battery is relocated inside the cab, it must be secured to the floor and covered to protect the driver
- 17. Needs to have a complete wood or steel box
- 18. Split rims will not be allowed.
- 19. Glass does not need to be removed
- 20. Truck numbers need to be legible & displayed on both truck doors
- 21. Helmet, Long sleeves, pants, gloves required to compete
- 22. Officials decision is final
